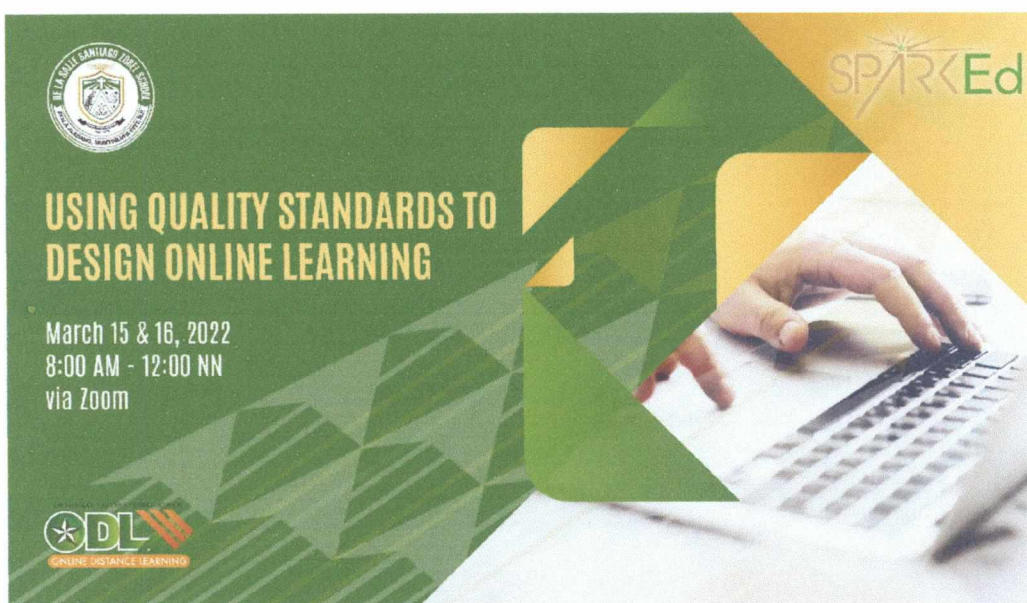

Greetings!

In light of our continuing efforts towards excellence in education, De La Salle Santiago Zobel School's SparkEd Center is organizing a **SparkEd Webinar-Workshop** for basic education learning leaders.

With the theme, "**Using Quality Standards to Design Online Learning**", the webinar-workshop aims to present quality standards as the framework for a school's supervision of the development and delivery of online learning experiences and materials based on research on best practices and principles of effective online teaching. This is based on the National Standards for Quality Online Courses and Teaching set by the

International Association for K-12 Online Learning (iNACOL). The topics covered include: *Professional Responsibilities, Digital Pedagogy, Community Building, Learner Engagement, Digital Citizenship, Diverse Instruction, Assessment and Measurement and Instructional Design.*

At present, the Department of Education does not have a set of national standards for online learning. However, standards for online learning in K12 schools have been established by other educational associations. These standards are research-based and field tested; hence, they provide adequate guidance for schools looking for standards to use for their supervision and quality assurance of online learning.

**With this in mind, may we request your good office to endorse this workshop to all the public and private schools under your jurisdiction?** We have attached herewith the draft of the invitation letter addressed to the school heads to be signed by you, inviting the participation of your Principal, Academic Vice-Principal, Subject Coordinators, Teachers or other personnel in similar positions of responsibility for curriculum development, instruction and assessment of student learning for our upcoming **Webinar-Workshop on March 15-16, 2022 from 8:00am-12:00nn via Zoom.** Specifically, this webinar-workshop will focus on quality standards for a hybrid, blended, or entirely online distance learning setup and show how a subject module implements the standards in the design of its activities, assessments, and use of resources.

1. Identify quality standards from the National Standards for Quality Online Courses and Teaching related to design, instruction and assessment;
2. Discuss examples of school practice of the standards;
3. Evaluate current school practices in the light of quality standards; and
