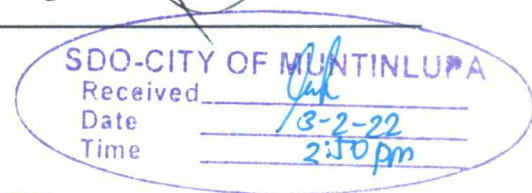

In line with the demands for a fearless journalism, Explained PH Online Press Conference aims to:

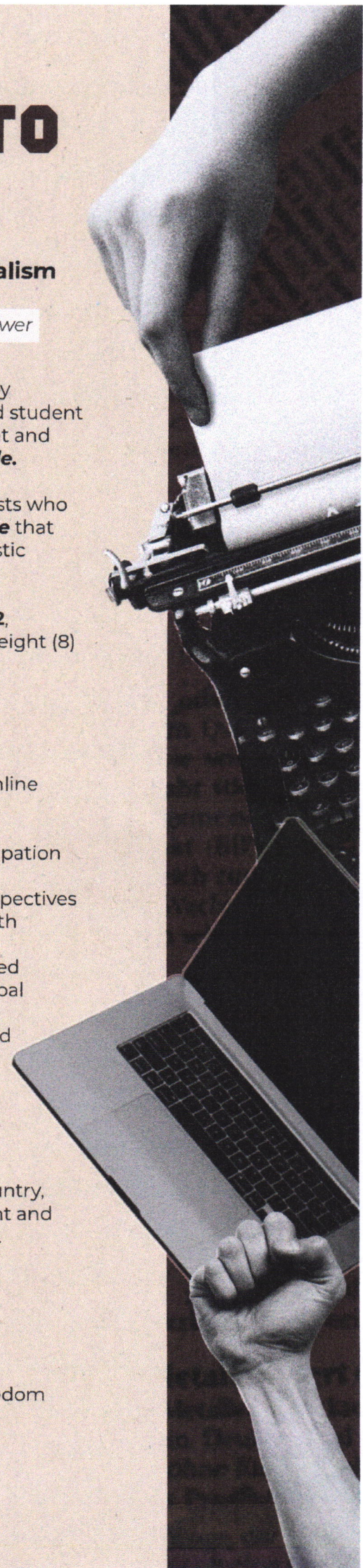
1. Provide an avenue for strengthening youth political participation to uphold the mandates of campus press;

COLLECTIVE STATEMENT

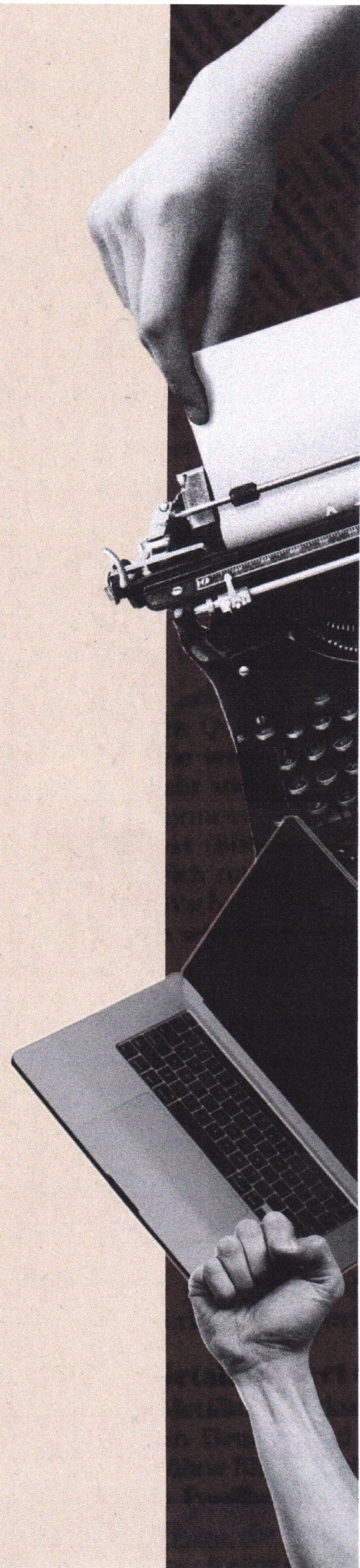

- f. The judging criteria, along with the panel of judges, will be released before the contest proper.

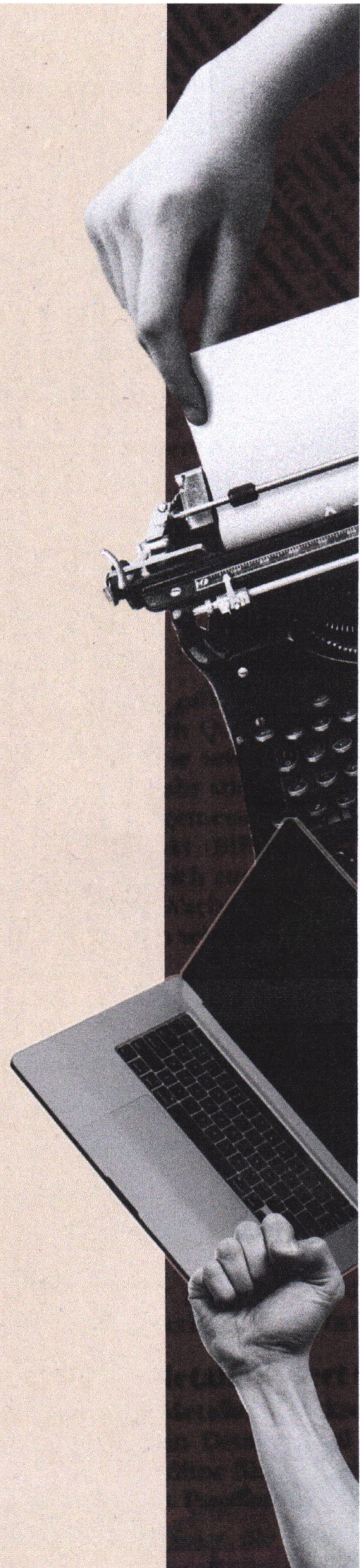

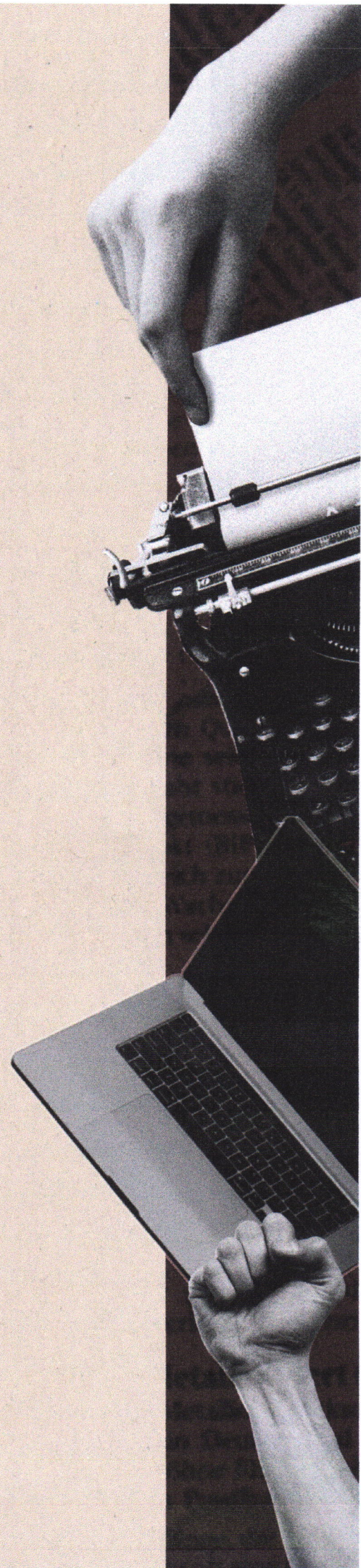
GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION

4. Violation of terms, conditions, and policies of the competition.



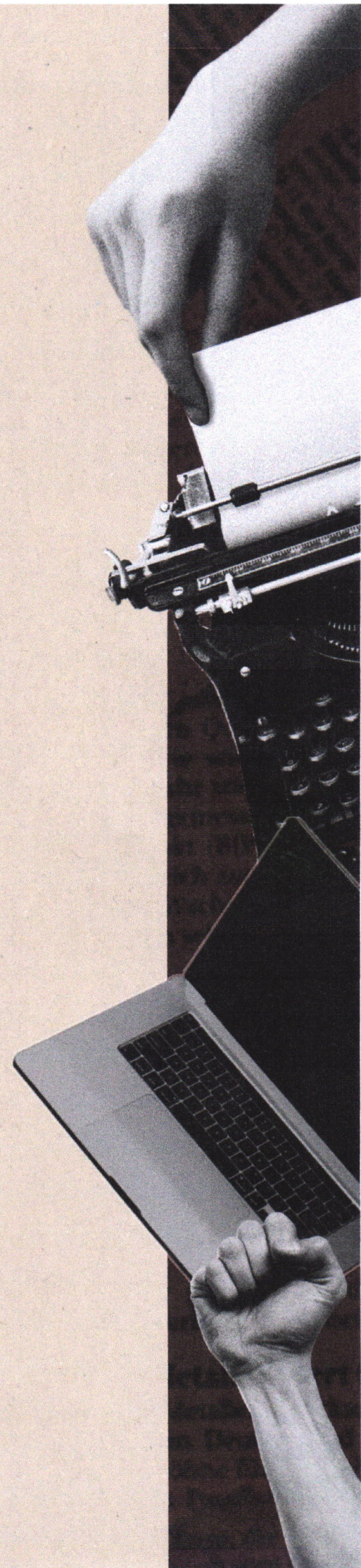
