(3-day Webinar)

I. RATIONALE

The occurrence of COVID19 tested everything, including the foundations on which the systems of the government were built. The effectivity of policies, rules, regulations and operational systems were put to test. It is noticeable that some were irrelevant as contrasted to a few that met the needs of time. It is for this reason that leaders should assess the existing rules, regulations, programs and operational systems if they are still relevant to this present time. Leaders should strategize futuristic solutions to problems, and effect the necessary changes for better public service.

The Supreme Court in the case of People of the Philippines vs. Naval ruled that "xxx a statesman thinks of the next generation." Since the application of the concept of statesmanship is not limited to politicians but more on one's election or appointment to public service, people occupying the position, leaders or not, should be responsible enough to make sure that every rule, policy, program and system would establish things that will last until the next generation of Filipinos. Learning lessons brought about by the pandemic, best practices of different agencies should be adopted and enhanced while obsolete ones should be upgraded.
