## rationale

In line with these goals, Lampara II will be a two-week-long celebration of Mindanaoan storytelling through a social media campaign-promoting and advocating for local history, heritage, arts, and customs. The event also aims to shed "light" on less-told stories all over Mindanao by giving platforms to local groups, artists, and personalities to narrate their stories. Additionally, it aims to tackle timely socio-political issues through various artistic expressions. The summit culminates on the last day packed with synchronous activities that comprise a quiz show, and a webinar, embodying this year's theme, designated for junior and senior high school students all over the country.

As an organization anchored on social awareness and responsibility, with the commitment of taking steps for achieving just peace and genuine development in Mindanao, UP Kalinaw believes that this event can be a powerful platform to manifest these goals and principles into fruition.
