**Abstract:**

More and more research is discovering that the brain is much more activated by movement than by seatwork, which increases fatigue and reduces concentration. Educators are now saying that –the greater the duration of time in the chair, the greater the student’s despair. For example, how can teachers give their students the opportunity to experience concepts in physical way? When children use their bodies to demonstrate how high and low, wide and narrow a shape is, they greatly enhance their understanding of these intellectual and mathematical concepts. When they act out words and stories, children add dimensions to their comprehensions and understanding and are for more likely to remember what they have engaged with.

Having worked on almost everything in EFL/ESL field and taught children for two decades, the speaker will be sharing his expertise and consider what is meant by transformation in the 21<sup>st</sup> century classroom and will introduce innovative ideas from recent research he has conducted with teachers who are in the process of transforming their practices, their identities as teachers, and the way they interact with their learners (Brazil, 2022).

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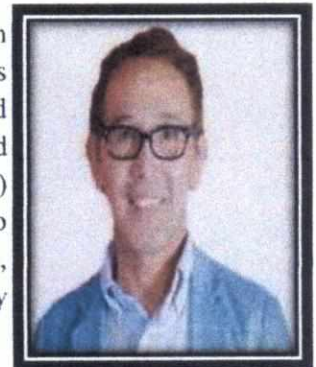
