- 2. Amateur category open for professors and faculty members currently working in any public and private elementary and high schools, state colleges and universities (SUCs, and higher educational institutes (HEIs) in the Philippines.
- Student category intended for senior high school students (grades 11-12) and college students currently enrolled in public and private schools in the Philippines for SY 2022-2023.

In this regard, we would like to request your assistance to disseminate this to all public primary and secondary schools in your division.

All interested participants are required to pre-register using this link: https://tinyurl.com/2022AnimationContestReg. Registration period will be until 31 July 2022. While the submission of entries will be from August 31 to September 9, 2022. Announcement and awarding of winners will be on September 27-29, 2022 during the CALABARZON Regional Science and Technology Week 2022 Celebration.

CONTEST ON ANIMATED PROMOTIONAL MATERIALS 2022

Concept: "Kwento ng Pagbangon"

An Animation Contest for the Promotion of DOST Programs and Services

Contest Guidelines

1. Rationale

This year, the Animation Contest will be a national contest organized by the Department of Science and Technology-CALABARZON (DOST-CALABARZON) in partnership with the University of Rizal System. This contest aims to continue mainstreaming animation by developing animated promotional materials, displaying the resiliency of Filipinos with the S&T interventions of DOST, as we continue to adapt in the digital world in the new normal brought by the COVID pandemic. It also aims to realize the potential of animation in industries, in providing alternative home-based jobs, and to spotlight the skillful animators throughout the country, and to promote DOST Programs and Services, like the RDCHIME Laboratory as a future center for animation excellence.

2. Categories

The contest has three categories classified into the following:

- a. Professional Category open for individuals who are experienced (have a portfolio) and animators by profession. To use 3D animation softwares.
- b. Amateur Category open for professors and other faculty members currently working in any public and private elementary and high schools, state colleges and universities (SUCs), and higher education institutes (HEIs) in the Philippines. To use blended 2D and 3D animation softwares / techniques.
- c. Student Category open for senior high school (grades 11-12) and college students currently enrolled in public and private schools in the Philippines for SY 2022-2023. To use 2D animation softwares.

Interested participants may compete as solo or as a group (maximum of five (5) members). Entries for all categories will be recognized with their affiliated School/Organization, if any. However, all participants must join in one (1) category AND one (1) group ONLY

3. Requirements and Mechanics

- Interested participants must register first at tinyurl.com/2022AnimationContestReg. Registration period will be until July 31, 2022.
- Successful registered participants will receive an email from the organizing team acknowledging their interest and providing the contest guidelines.
- c. The participants from all the categories submit a video entry in line with the concept "Kwento ng Pagbangon" (Story of Resilience) and featuring a DOST Program or Service.
- d. The animation should only be minimum of 3 minutes and maximum of 5mins long.
- e. Video requirements for 2D animation:
 - Various animation software may be applied/used such as Adobe, Movie maker, Toon Boom, and alike.
 - The video dimension of the animation should be 1280 x 720 pixels.
- f. Video Requirements for 3D animation:

- Elements may be modeled using various software such as Maya, Blender, Synfig, and the like.
- ii. All objects and characters should be modeled in 3D using software similar to (i).
- Recommended video output properties: *.mp4 or *.avi video format, 1280 x
 720 pixels, 30fps minimum.
- g. Background music, objects, and clip art should be from open source and must contain no copyright.
- h. The entry must be submitted to dost4a.animcontest@gmail.com with the following subject format: "ANIMATION2022_[CATEGORY]_[NAME or GROUP NAME]" (Example: ANIMATION2022_Student_JuanDelaCruz]) from August 31 (Wednesday) to September 9, 2022 (Friday, 5:00PM) only.
- The qualified participants shall authorize DOST-CALABARZON and URS on the following provisions:
 - DOST-CALABARZON shall have the exclusive rights to use all the entries in its communication and publication materials including but not limited to online publications, calendars, and planners.
 - URS shall have the copyright of all the entries submitted in this contest.
- j. By joining the contest, all participants agree to release and discharge DOST-CALABARZON and URS officials and employees from any claims, losses, or damage arising from their participation.
- k. For amateur and student categories, the participants must agree that their names and their school/division being represented may be released to the public for the purpose of announcing the contest finalists and winners.

4. Judging and Criteria

- a. The Panel of Judges will be composed of representatives from the following agencies:
 - Science and Technology Information Institute (DOST STII)
 - Experts on 2D and 3D animation (TESDA)
 - Philippine High School for the Arts (PHSA)
 - National ICT Confederation of the Philippines (NICP)
 - University of Rizal System (URS) from academe
- b. The entries will be evaluated based on the following criteria:
 - Originality (30%)

Originality of the video entry pertains to the uniqueness of the visual elements used in the entry, such as characters, backgrounds, and objects. Majority of the elements in the video must be from the participant's own work. The animated video should introduce new characters and without any resemblance with well-known commercial or existing secular characters. The graphics must not be adopted from any patented images.

Story Relevance (20%)

The video should remain relevant to the theme and with the purpose of delivering a story and promotion of DOST Programs and Services creatively through animated characters and objects. The video must be able to strongly adhere to the concept. It must be understandable by the viewing audience without the

presence of any violent presentation or compromise in the audience value system.

Movement Quality (30%)

Entries should use animation principles. It should have at least one (1) character animated within the duration of the video. The animated video should possess a smooth, timely, and necessary transition applicable to the intentions of the video. It should also be presenting emphasis on the 12 principles of animation that can be observed or watched within a single or series of scenes.

Promotional Impact (20%)

This refers to the appeal of the video to the viewer. The animated video should be appealing enough that make a viewer engaged with the animated video. And the animated video managed to capture the concept within the allowed time.

c. The decision of the Panel of Judges shall be final and irrevocable. The final score of the winners will be announced during the awarding. The Panel of Judges reserves the right to declare NO winner for any category if entry/-ies fail to meet the following criterion: obtaining NO individual judge's score less than 85% and garnering an AVERAGE score of 85% or more. Any part of the scorecards or rating sheets are NOT for public scrutiny and may only be provided upon the request of the participant.

5. Schedule of Activities

6. Announcement of Winners / Awarding of Prizes

Only one (1) winner shall be selected per category. In case of tie, the Panel of Judges shall convene to break the tie and declare only one winner.

The winners shall receive the following prizes during the DOST-CALABARZON's Regional Science and Technology Week (RSTW) Awarding Ceremony:
