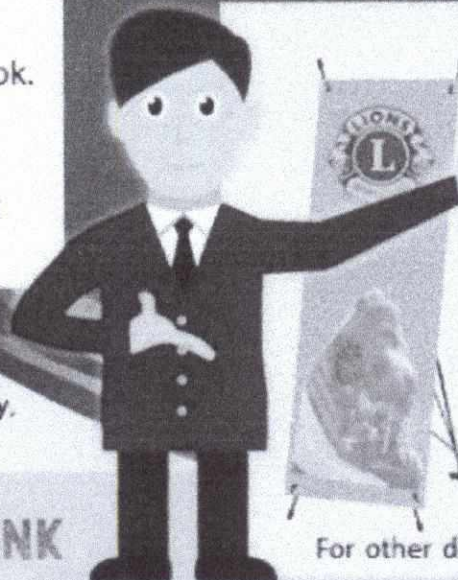

The Call for Poster and Oral Presentations for the CARAPE 2022 (Conclave of Aloysian Researchers, Authors & Published Educators) is open to all members and non-members of the Aloysian Publications. The deadline for submission is on August 10, 2022 (Wednesday).

MECHANICS FOR THE POSTER and ORAL PRESENTATIONS:

1. All submission is via electronic mail, address to:

The deadline for submissions is on August 10, 2022 (Wednesday).
2. Along with the poster layout in JPEG format, also send a PDF copy of the abstract. Content of the abstract must be:
 - a. Short introduction
 - b. Objectives
 - c. Methodology
 - d. Results and Conclusions
 - e. Keywords
3. All abstract submissions for poster presentation will initially be evaluated on the abstracts alone based on the parameters for evaluation:
 - a. Topic and content are about education, however, multidisciplinary topics are also accepted.
 - b. Scientific soundness of the research
 - c. Abstract should be 250-400 words, single paragraph, and no subtitles.
4. All participating researchers must prepare a 5-minute RAPID TALK Presentation about their poster to be delivered to the viewers during the poster exhibit hopping.

5. Best 10 papers will be presented during the plenary. Oral presenters will be notified ahead of time for them to prepare with PPT of the paper and a 15-minute talk. It is understood the oral presenters are selected from the poster presentation participants based on the abstract submitted.

6. Posters format

- a. All posters should be submitted as JPEG.
- b. Minimum font size of 24.
- c. Poster layout should be in portrait.
- d. Size of the poster depends on the size of the available banner stand (X banner standee or roll-up banner stand) in the market but the standard sizes are 2.5 x 6 feet, 3 x 6 feet, and 2.75 x 6.5 feet. You may order the banner standee in Lazada or Shoppe at a minimal cost. Put at least a 1 cm border on all sides.
- e. Design format and creativity are left to the discretion of the participant/s
- f. Filename format for submission: family name.first name.poster.carape2022
- g. Content of the poster should include the following:
 - i. Title of Research
 - ii. Author/s and Affiliation (school/university, district, and region)
 - iii. Introduction (reduced)
 - iv. Methods
 - v. Results
 - vi. Discussion (reduced)
 - vii. Conclusion
 - viii. Reference/s - only those used in the poster

7. Participating poster presenters must bring their own banner standee and printed poster on the tarpaulin.

8. Major and minor awards will be given for Best Poster and Oral Presentations.

9. Poster and Oral Presentations are free of charge for the registered participants to CARAPE 2022. In case there are multiple authors/presenters of a particular paper, all of them must register individually at CARAPE 2022.

10. Since this is a face-to-face conclave, all participants must appear personally at CARAPE 2022. There will be no online running of this event.
