SUBJECT : Values Restoration Program

The Council for the Restoration of Filipino Values (CRFV), a Civil Service Commission Accredited Learning and Development Institution, aims to introduce its **Values Restoration Program** as a soft approach of the government's anti-corruption initiatives.

In line with this, government agencies are encouraged to support the program by appointing at least two Values Restoration Officers (VRO), from supervisory level and rank and file from their central, regional, provincial, and field offices or units. The designated VRO shall lead the discussion of a common value every week after the flag ceremony using the CRFV-authored book **transforming the Nation through Values** and the CD with Powerpoint presentations containing the same. Moreover, the designated VRO shall coordinate all VRO matters in their agencies and attend the Trainer's Trainings and other seminars and meetings to be conducted by the CRFV.

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DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF A VALUES RESTORATION OFFICER FROM A GOVERNMENT AGENCY:

1. Closely collaborate with the Values Restoration Officer (VRO) from the Private Sector for the teaching of the weekly Value Focus during the flag ceremony and 20-minute classroom discussion among the employees of the department or agency;
2. Effectively arrange the schedule for the classroom discussion so as not to impede the rendition of effective public service;
3. In the absence of the VRO from the Private Sector, he/she will perform the necessary duties of his or her counterpart VRO from the private sector particularly the teaching of the weekly value focus during the flag ceremony and during the classroom type discussion.

QUALIFICATIONS OF THE VALUES RESTORATION OFFICER FROM A GOVERNMENT AGENCY:

1. He/she must be of good moral character and active advocate of good governance by modelling it before the other government personnel;
2. He/she is of good conduct based on the evaluation of his/her Head of Office and based on the judgment and general observation of his/her co-employees in the agency;
3. He/she should have been one of the best performing employees in the government agency and have not been held guilty or liable of non-feasance, misfeasance, or malfeasance in office or of any flagrant violation of laws and reasonable rules and regulations of the agency.
4. He/she must be between 30-60 years old.



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VRO Training the Trainers (VROTTT) Training Design

I. Rationale:

To efficiently implement the Values Restoration Program in cognizance to CSC Announcement No. 40 series 2017, a VRO must be competently equipped with the knowledge, skills and attitude relevant to transforming the agency/office through values. Thus, this program is designed to address such need by intertwining skills training and values enhancement towards transformational leadership.

II. Learning Objectives:

At the end of the course, the participants shall be able to demonstrate the capacity and commitment to champion values. Specifically, the participants shall be able to:

1. Appreciate and articulate the goals and importance of implementing Values Restoration Program in nation-building;
2. Identify the core values that one should embody to effectively lead and advocate for transformation through values;
3. Create a brief values advocacy presentation; and (4) Develop an initial action plan for values enhancement in their respective offices/agencies.

III. Course Content:

1. An overview of the goals and relevance of Values Restoration Program in the context of transformation.
2. Concept briefing of the following (Trainers' Training Course):
 - a. Principles of Trainer Excellence
 - b. Characteristics of adult learners, their motivations, learning styles and their learning environments
 - c. Different Roles of a trainer and trainee, and how to manage the latter.
 - d. The Trainer and his/her professional presence in the context of VRP.
3. Core Values Identification:
 - Value-focus: Spirituality
 - Value-focus: Excellence
 - Value-focus: Integrity
 - Value-focus: Taming the Tongue
 - Value-focus: Patriotism (Selfless Love and Service to People)

IV. Methodology:

1. Evocative lecture
2. Open forum
3. Application of Principles of Trainer Excellence during teaching demonstration
4. Give and receive feedback
5. Other participative digital methodologies
