Founded in 1923, the Philippine Librarians Association, Inc. (PLAI) is one of the oldest library associations in the Southeast Asia and the world. PLAI is the only Accredited Integrated Professional Organization (AIPO) of registered librarians in the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) with around 8,000 members all over the country represented by the 17 regional councils in the three island clusters of Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao.

Every year, the Association holds its regular meetings in the National Capital Region (NCR) since its headquarters is located at the National Library of the Philippines (NLP), T.M. Kalaw St., Ermita, Manila. Just this year, PLAI held two online meetings via Zoom while the third quarter was held at the NLP.

In partnership with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) through the National Committee on Library and Information Services (NCLIS), and the National Library of the Philippines (NLP), PLAI will be conducting its Annual National Congress on **22-25 November 2022** at the Iloilo Convention Center, Iloilo City, Philippines.

Moreover, the General Assembly will be held to present updates and provide a venue for discussion of concerns relating to the Association and to the profession in general.
