

RATIONALE

The Rizal Chapter Youth Assembly convenes all Red Cross Youth members, officers and advisers that encompass the jurisdiction of the Philippine Red Cross – Rizal Chapter in a week filled learning activities and networking for our youth and advisers.

In addition to the 19th Rizal Chapter Youth Assembly is the election of the next set of **Area Youth Representatives** (AYRs) of the following branches:

- Makati City
- Mandaluyong City
- Muntinlupa City
- Paranague City
- Pasig City-Pateros

- San Juan City
- Taguig City
- Antipolo City and South Rizal
- East Rizal
- West Rizal


The elected AYRs will then elect among them the officers of the Rizal Chapter Youth Council for the Year 2022 – 2024. The CYC President represents the youth sector in the Board of Directors, the highest policy-making body in PRC - Rizal Chapter. Working under the umbrella of the National Youth Council, the CYC represents all the RCY Councils within the jurisdiction of the chapter. While it implements various activities and projects for its member councils, the CYC also sets policies upon approval of the Executive Youth Committee that will contribute to the total development and retention of all organized and accredited RCY Councils.

There will also be a review of the Rizal Chapter Youth Council Constitution and By-Laws as there was an update on the National Youth Council Constitution and By-Laws as adopted in the National Youth Congress.

Simultaneously, the assembly of all RCY Advisers will include the election of the next set of **Advisers' League Representatives** (ALRs) of the following branches:

- Mandaluyong City
- Muntinlupa City
- Paranaque City
- Pasig City-Pateros

OBJECTIVES

General:

Increase the promotion of voluntary service and strong network among the RCY Councils by gathering and igniting their creativity and innovation through meaningful discussions and workshops by empowering the youth in addressing the thematic issues of the PRC.

Specific:

- Assemble at least three hundred (300) Red Cross Youth volunteers and advisers of accredited Senior, Senior Plus, College and Community Red Cross Youth Councils encompassing the jurisdiction of the Rizal Chapter.
- Elect new set of Area Youth Representatives (AYR) from the 10 branches of the Rizal Chapter.
- Review and update the Rizal CYC Constitution and By-Laws as adopted in the National Youth Congress.
- Elect new set of Advisers' League Representatives (ALR) from the 10 areas of the Rizal Chapter.
- 5. Spark creativity and innovation by igniting servant-leadership and volunteerism among the participants through different plenary sessions and breakout sessions.
- Foster camaraderie and strong network among the youth and advisers of the different Red Cross Youth Councils.


REGISTRATION AND DELEGATION

Each council is expected to send at least seven (7) participants with a maximum of 3 youth delegates, 2 youth observers, and at least 2 RCY advisers. The Chapter Youth Assembly is FREE of charge.

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR DELEGATES AND OBSERVERS

All youth delegates and observers must take note of the following qualifications and requirements:

- Has finished either the Leadership Development Program (LDP) or Youth Volunteer Orientation Module (YVOM)
- 2. Must be physically and mentally fit
- 3. Must be a member/volunteer of an accredited RCY Council
- 4. Active in their RCY Council certified by their Adviser/s
- 5. As much as possible, an officer or leader of the RCY Council
- Has submitted the Council Registration Form attached with the following necessary documents needed by the Secretariat Committee for the Assembly on or before September 30, 2022:
 - a. Waiver from the Parent or Guardian
 - b. Photo and Video Documentation Waiver
 - Endorsement from the School/Community Head
 - d. Registration Form



QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR AYR CANDIDATES/NOMINEES

All Red Cross Youth who are interested to become a candidate for the Election of Area Youth Representatives must take note of the following qualifications and requirements:

- Has finished either the Leadership Development Program (LDP) or Youth Volunteer Formation Course (YVFC)
- 2. Must be physically and mentally fit
- 3. Must be within the age range of 12-28 years old on the day of the election
- 4. Must be a member/volunteer of an accredited RCY Council
- 5. As much as possible, an officer or leader of the RCY Council
- 6. Must submit a 2-minute recorded video answering the following:
 - a. Introduction (Years in service, notable experiences and learnings)
 - b. What can you contribute to the council if elected as AYR?
- Has completed the Nomination Form attached with the following necessary documents needed by the Secretariat Committee for the Assembly on or before September 30, 2022:
 - a. Endorsement from the School/Community Heads
 - b. Photocopy of LDP Certificate
 - c. Photocopy of Birth Certificate
 - d. Certificate of Good Moral Character
 - e. Parents' Approval Letter (if under 18 years old)
- 7. Has submitted the Council Registration Form attached with the following necessary documents needed by the Secretariat Committee for the Assembly on or before September 30, 2022:
 - e. Waiver from the Parent or Guardian
 - f. Photo and Video Documentation Waiver
 - g. Endorsement from the School/Community Head
 - h. Registration Form





- 1.10.5 Must be physically, mentally and emotionally fit;
- 1.10.6 Must be actively involved in RCY activities certified by the council adviser;
- 1.10.7 Must have the consent of his parents of his candidacy if below 18 years of age
- 1.11 Nomination of Candidates Any eligible delegate may be nominated. Every nomination shall be written and shall be submitted to the Committee on Nominations and Elections on the time and place designated by the committee with written consent of the nominee.
- 1.12 Disqualification of Proceedings Any questions relating to the eligibility of a candidate must be raised prior to the casting of ballots and shall immediately be decided by the Committee on Nominations and Elections. The decision of the committee is final and irrevocable.
- 1.13 Voting Voting shall be by secret ballot. Official ballots shall be provided for the purpose. Voting by proxy shall not be allowed.
- 1.14 Certification of Election Results Election shall be determined by plurality of votes. Any tie shall be broken by drawing of lots. The Chairperson of the Board of Canvassers immediately after all ballots have been canvassed and tallied, shall transmit all the results of the election to the Chairperson of the Committee on Nominations and Elections who shall then announce the results to the body.
- 1.15 Induction of Officers the duly elected AYRs shall immediately be proclaimed by the Committee on Nominations and Elections and officially be inducted into office during the Chapter Youth Assembly.

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ELECTION RULES AND PROCEDURES (ERAP)

Election Rules and Procedures were taken from Article VI Section 1 of the Chapter Youth Council Constitution and By-Laws

Section 1. Rules Governing Election

- 1.1 Date and place of the Election The general election of the AYRs shall be held during the Chapter Youth Assembly, on the date and place as maybe recommended by the Executive Committee and approved by the Chapter Administrator and Board of Directors.
- 1.2 The Committee on Nominations and Elections (C.O.N.E.) shall be composed of twelve (12) members, which is comprised of the Chairman and Vice Chairman of whom are officers of the CYC appointed by the Executive Committee and ten (10) representing all branches.
- 1.3 In case that all AYRs will seek re-election, the Chairman and the Vice Chairman shall be appointed by the Committee on Nominations and Elections coming from the council of presidents who does not have a running candidate.
- 1.4 The responsibilities and functions of the Committee on Nominations and Elections are:
 - 1.4.1 The formulation of rules, regulations and procedures:
 - 1.4.2 The preparation of all election materials and facilities;
 - 1.4.3 The registration of voters.
- 1.5 Power to Vote only duly accredited delegates shall be allowed to vote. Each council shall be entitled to three (3) delegates.
- 1.6 The allocation of delegates with the power to vote on the general election shall have a number equal for each RCY Council as specified by the C.O.N.E. There shall also be youth observers whose number shall not exceed that of the delegates. They shall have the privilege to participate in the deliberations but not to vote.
- 1.7 Election campaign materials in order to inform the delegates of the qualifications of the candidates, the Committee on Nominations and Elections shall make available to them the bio data of the candidates before the start of the assembly.
- 1.8 At any time prior to the presentation of official candidates, electioneering (e.g. using the facilities or the floor of the assembly to campaign for and against a candidate, entertainment of delegates and distribution of campaign materials and giveaways by the candidates themselves, the campaign leaders or members) shall be strictly prohibited.
- 1.9 Two weeks prior to the election of the AYRs, the candidates are required to submit their accredited service reports and candidacy forms.
- 1.10 Eligibility for candidacy:
 - 1.10.1 Must be a bonafide Red Cross Youth Volunteer/Member;
 - 1.10.2 Must be 12-23 years of age;
 - 1.10.3 Must be a resident and member of an RCYC under the jurisdiction of Rizal Chapter for a period of one-year preceding the election;
 - 1.10.4 Must have a good moral character duly certified by the school administration or Barangay Chairman as in the case of CommRCY;
