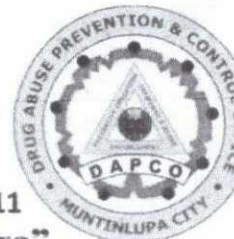

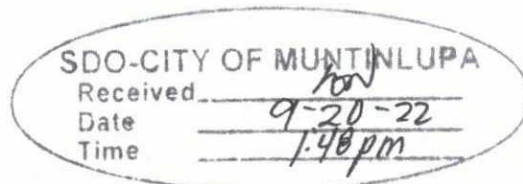

with ID FIRST 15 TO REGISTER

GENERAL RULES:

1. The student-contestant shall be endorsed by the School Participant or Director by signing the attached entry form which must be submitted to DAPCO on or before October 28, 2022
2. To ensure uniformity of materials to be utilized, the Organizer (DAPCO) shall provide the art materials and tools to be used for the competition. No other materials will be allowed.
3. Contestants must come in their **Official PE Uniform with ID** along with their Official Coach or Teacher. Coach/Teacher may not approach their students during the competition proper.
4. The theme for this years' celebration is " _____," from which contestants must base their slogan and design.
5. "First Come First Consider Policy" will be practiced. The Organizer will limit its admission to 15 contestants only. **Please come on time. Registration starts at 7:30 am. Contest Proper starts at 8:00 in the morning. Once the contest starts, no late participants will be entertained.**
6. Participants will be given three (3) hours to finish their work.
7. Poster design and **slogan (in Filipino)** must be drawn in one and the same Illustration Board that will be provided by the Organizer. In case of massive damage in the surface of the illustration board, the Organizer will provide replacement only once.
8. All entries shall become exclusive property of the Organizer. All posters will be used for making 2023 DAPCO Calendar.

General Rules:

1. Any contestant participating in this event will not be allowed to take part in other event in DAPCOLYMPICS.
2. The student-contestant shall be endorsed by the School Participant or Director by signing the entry form which must be submitted to DAPCO on or before October 28, 2022.
3. Student must be accompanied by Coach/Teacher on Contest day and must be at the venue early, in school uniform with ID. Strictly no coaching while contest is in progress.
4. "First Come First Consider Policy" shall be adopted as the Organizer can only accommodate first 15 registrants.
5. Student will be provided with a small board where the contestant's answer will be written, along with chalk and eraser.
6. The Questions will be asked in a Multiple Choice format and contestant need only write A, B, C, and D corresponding to his answer.
7. Elimination process:
 - a. There shall be TEN (10) questions for the Elimination. Top ten (10) contestants shall be included in the Semi Final Round.
 - b. Back to Zero. Ten (10) questions for the Semi-Final Round. Top five (5) contestants with the highest scores that be included in the Final round.
 - c. Back to Zero. Five (5) questions for the Final Round. Contestant earning the highest score shall be declared Champion, First Runner-Up and Second Runner-Up.
 - d. In cases of tie in all rounds, three (3) additional questions will be asked to the contenders to determine who among them will garner highest points
 - e. For any changes or improvisation on the above mentioned rules, the rule of Majority Votes shall apply.
8. Please come on time. Registration starts at 7:30am Contest Proper starts at 8:30 am. Once the contest starts, no late participants will be entertained.

General Rules:

1. Any contestant participating in this event will not be allowed to take part in other DAPCOLYMPIC events.
2. Participants must be officially endorsed by the School Principal through the Official entry form accompanying this communication and must be submitted to DAPCO on or before October 28, 2022.
3. "First Come First Consider" Policy shall be practiced as the Organizer will limit its admission of contestants to only 9 groups.
4. Official Entry (music and lyrics) must be an original composition. Lyrics must be in Filipino and must be submitted to the Organizer in 3 copies (1 for each judge) properly labelled with school name; each on short bond paper and short folders on the day of the competition upon registration. Strictly no obscene or foul language.
5. Time limit for each entry shall be a minimum of 3 minutes and a maximum of 5 minutes. Less or more than the set time limits will incur a 5 points deduction from the average total score from the three judges. Time limit does not include ingress and egress from the stage. A maximum of five (5) minutes will be given for each group to set up on stage.
6. Contestants may bring with them and use whatever musical instrument, CD USB it needs to package its entry. Accompanying music must be a minus one. No pre recording of the jingle (song). And bear in mind that it is not the melody that counts but the lyrics which must be clearly heard and understood by the judges.
7. Contestants may use costumes and/or props as they deem necessary. Just take note of the time consideration for the ingress and egress on stage to avoid point deduction.
8. All entries shall become the exclusive property of the Organizer.
9. Please come on time. Once the contest starts, no late participants will be entertained.

**DECLARING THE THIRD WEEK OF NOVEMBER OF EVERY YEAR AS
"DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION AND CONTROL WEEK"**

WHEREAS, a nationwide and a systematically-coordinated community information drive against the evils of drug abuse will contribute to a large degree in the prevention and control of drug dependency;

WHEREAS, in the 9th Meeting of ASEAN Senior Officials on Drug Matters held in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, in September 1985, the ASEAN member countries agreed to celebrate annually the Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Week in November of every year; and

WHEREAS, there is a felt need to increase awareness and understanding of the adverse effects of drug abuse not only on the health of our people but also on our social, economic and even the political development of our country.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GLORIA MACAPAGAL-ARROYO, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare the third week of November of every year as "DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION AND CONTROL WEEK" under the auspices of the Dangerous Drugs Board.

I call upon all agencies of the government, professional, civic and religious organizations, and the mass media to extend their wholehearted cooperation with and support to the Dangerous Drugs Board in this laudable endeavor.

Done in the City of Manila, this 26th day of November, in the year of Our Lord, two thousand and one.


