Dear Sir / Madam,

Discrimination and violence against people of diverse sexual orientation, gender identity and physical handicapped is a serious matter around the world. Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender (LGBT) and PWD workers face discrimination in the labour market throughout the employment cycle because of their perceived or actual sexual orientation and physical handicap. They may be denied access to employment, to training and promotion, and access to social security. Since LGBT and PWD workers are unlikely to be well represented in government structures, or in employers' and workers' organizations, their interests are rarely the subject of social dialogue or reflected in collective agreements. Consequently, when they encounter discrimination, harassment or bullying, the avenues for workplace dispute resolution may be scarce.

PCCI - South Sector together with the City of Muntinlupa is supporting the elimination of discrimination in the world of work, promoting workplace diversity and achieving decent work for all women and men, including, PWD, people of diverse sexual orientation and gender identity. The right to equal treatment and opportunities is primarily a rights issue, and the city must deliver upon its mandate to end discrimination in the workplace in all its forms by giving incentives and encouraging companies to promote equality. In addition, by urging students to live according to these principles at school, we remove a barrier to the holistic development of LGBT and PWD students, fostering a welcoming and secure learning environment. Additionally, there will be a lecture series from international and local dignitaries ,wherein, participants will learn about entrepreneurship, landing a job, and developing their personalities, all of which would help them get equipped for life in the real world.

In line with this, may we invite your office to join us on November 29, 2022 08:30 AM to 05:00 PM, at Ayala Malls Southpark, Muntinlupa City for Diversity & Pride @ Work: "Welcome Inclusivity, Embrace Diversity and Take Pride at Work" An Employment Fair for the Minority to advocate the LGBT and PWD the right to educational and working environment and forum with a theme: "Collaborations for Enhancing Education & Capacity Building for Employability & Sustainable Future". Additionally, we would like to request for your permission and endorsement in allowing the students and faculty of different High Schools public and private here in Muntinlupa City to attend the said event. At least Thirty (30) seats will be reserved for each school, but more can be made available. All participants who expressed interest in attending the lecture will also receive certificates upon completion of the event.
