

Joint Since 2004, Piling Obrang Vidyo (POV) has been a space for a lot of student filmmakers to create their mark - have their voice heard and a chance to exhibit their short films on the big screen. Since then, POV has become a platform to empower the stories of the Filipho youth.

In its 19th year, POV XIX remains bold and proactive with the heme Bagong S19lo: Atin ang Kwento. With the easing of pandemic-related restrictions, POV XIX is bringing the annual film estival competition back home, at UPFI Film Center's Cine Adama. As we redeem this space for cinematic discourse, POV also aims to eclaim the narrative of the people by giving a platform for the Filipino youth to share their films and untoid stories that are yet to be delivered to the big screen. For the first time ever, POV will be opening the film competition not only to college students, but also to senior igh school students to further amplify the voice of the youth. 


ABOUT THE ORGANIZATION
