Greetings from GuidanceNGO!

GuidanceNGO, a non-government organization that conducts career seminars and webinars for more than 20 years, invites the schools within your division to take part in an online career and college fair titled **Career Expedition 2022-2023**, that happens weekly, specifically on a Friday. The schools will just choose which Friday their Grade 12 students will be available.

The Grade 12 students will get the chance to be oriented by program chairs, deans, and professors of outstanding colleges and universities about college programs they would like to pursue. Below are the topics that will be discussed in the Career Expedition event:

- a. Areas of study behind each college program
- b. Skills and Character students need to develop to pursue certain college programs
- c. The college training your Grade 12 students will go through for certain college programs
- d. The revised curricula of various college programs
- e. Employment opportunities behind each college program

The online event will happen from **September 2022** till **April 2023** every Friday from 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm. They will just choose one Friday when their Grade 12 students will be available.

1:00 to 3:00 pm – CAREER CLINIC, a focused consultation about college programs and careers. Four (4) 30-minute career clinic sessions featuring various college programs. Speakers will be the deans, program or department chairs, and professors of 48 college programs/careers listed below.
