

Financial Literacy School Roadshow for SHS students

Happy New Year!

We are proud to announce the return of the Financial Literacy Roadshow for Philippine Senior High Schools. This is a partnership between the Foundation for the Advancement of Life and Insurance Around the World (FALIA-Japan), the Philippine Life Insurance Association (PLIA-Philippines) and Knowledge Community (KCI-Philippines). This opportunity is made possible through the generous support of FALIA and is being provided to schools <u>free of charge</u>.

The project has been held since 2017 and was discontinued temporarily in 2021 due to the covid-19 pandemic. From 2017 to 2020, we have conducted the roadshow in senior high schools in Metro Manila, Cavite, Laguna, Cebu, Mandaue, Talisay, Bulacan, Nueva Ecija, Tarlac, Zambales, and Batangas.

For the fifth round (SY 2022 – 2023) of the financial planning roadshow, we would like to invite four (4) senior high schools from the DepEd Division of Muntinlupa City to participate in the project which has two components:

- 1. a 2-hour lecture for senior high schools on financial planning
- 2. an essay-writing competition to be organized by each school

This project is an excellent opportunity for the senior high school students to learn about financial management and planning, an important skill to succeed in life. We will not be selling any insurance product or promoting any insurance company. This is simply an information and education campaign on financial literacy.

The winners will be determined by a committee composed of financial planning and English essay composition experts.

If you are amenable to joining the project, may we request your office to nominate four (4) senior high schools from your division that meet the criteria as described below. We will be conducting the roadshow in the different divisions from January 20 to February 24, 2023. We will visit the school once to conduct a 2-hour financial planning workshop for the senior high students.

School Selection Criteria:

- School principal and SHS coordinator must be supportive of the program
- School must have a SHS population of at least 100 students
- School must have a venue for the f2f lecture compliant to covid-19 protocols, and able to provide an LCD projector, white screen, and sound system
- School must be able to form a committee who will select and submit the best essays from their students. Each school must be able to submit at least twelve (12) student essay entries, maximum of 3 pages for each entry.
