MECHANICS

- a. Open to all Junior and Senior High School Students (Grade 7-12)
- b. Must be drawn/illustrated in a ½ size illustration board (PORTRAIT LAYOUT)
 size shall be strictly observed, otherwise entry will be disqualified.
- c. All submitted artworks must contain the following: title of the poster, materials used, full name of artist, age, gender, telephone number, and Fire district which shall be attached at the back of their entry.
- d. All entries must have relevance with the theme "Sa Pag-Iwas Sa Sunog, Hindi ka Nag-iisa"
- e. No identifying marks shall be allowed in all entries.
- f. The official entry of the winner from each city shall be submitted to their respective Fire District for the selection of one (1) grand winner who will represent their fire district and advance to the regional level.
- g. Materials will be provided but are not limited to:
 - 1/2 illustration board
 - Oil pastel/water color
 - Pencil
- h. The participants will be given two (2) hours to finish their artworks.
- All submitted entries shall become sole and exclusive property of the BFP and may be reproduced and/or reprinted in any size of exhibition without seeking permission from the owner or paying compensation for the acquisition of said posters.
- j. The decision of the selection committee and board of jurors is final and irrevocable. The board will not be obliged to give explanation for the results
- k. All participants can bring their own art coloring materials for the said activity.
