



**6th Inter- Senior High School General Business Quiz Bee  
Implementing Rules and Regulations**

- I. Qualifications of contestants
  1. All contestants must be bonafide Grade 12 senior high school students.
- II. Punctuality of the contestants
  1. Contestants are obliged to arrive 30 minutes before the quiz bee proper.
- III. Belongings of the contestants

The contestants are not allowed to bring anything with them during the quiz bee proper except their writing materials. Mobile phones, iPod, laptop and other electronic devices are not allowed to be used during the quiz bee proper. All bags and unnecessary items should be in the proper places provided by the committees.
- IV. Manner of reading and answering the questions
  1. The quizmaster shall read the questions twice.
  2. The quizzers are allowed to write on the answer board provided to them ONLY when the quizmaster says "GO!" For questions requiring computations, the contestants are allowed to write and solve on the scratch paper provided to them as the quizmaster reads the question. Any contestant who violates the said provision for the first time shall be given a warning; for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time, a decrease of 5 points to their total score. Violation of this provision for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time shall mean disqualification of the contestant.
  3. Before the time allotted has lapsed, contestants should have written their answer on the answer board. When the timer rings signaling the lapse of time allotted, the contestants should stop answering and must raise their answer board. Otherwise, the answer will be invalidated.
  4. The contestants are not allowed to erase what they have written in the answer board unless the quiz master has given the clearance.
  5. Contestants may neither glance nor talk to their seatmates during the quiz bee proper. Any contestant caught cheating will automatically be disqualified to the contest.
- V. Specific rules in the conduct of the quiz bee
  1. Teams are composed of 5 students (3 members, 2 alternates) from the same school. Each team must have one (1) coach.
  2. The quiz bee is composed of 3 levels namely: Easy, Average and Difficult. Time allotments and no. of questions are as follows:

Time allotment to answer	10 seconds	25 seconds	45 seconds	25 seconds
Number of questions	10 questions	10 questions	10 questions	
Point for every correct answer	2	3	5	



1. Subjects/courses covered in the quiz bee are as follows:

- Basic/Applied Economics
- Basic Mathematics
- Basic Finance
- Principles of Management
- Principles of Marketing
- Fundamentals of Accounting

VI. Rules on contestant's answer

1. The contestants should write their answers clearly and legibly on the answer boards provided to them.
2. Abbreviations are highly discouraged.
3. For questions requiring computations, the final answers shall be rounded off to the nearest hundredths.
4. For questions and clarifications regarding the correct answer, the contestants must address their concern to the judges immediately after the quizmaster has announced the answer.

VII. Declaration of winners

1. The committee shall provide an official tabulation of score during the quiz bee. Any discrepancies with the points shall be directed to the committee-in-charge for verification during the event.
2. The team who garnered the highest points will be declared as the Champion. In case there would be a tie, a clincher round will be provided to break the tie.
3. The decisions of the judges are final and irrevocable.

VIII. Prizes and Entrance Discounts for Winners

All participants shall be awarded a certificate of participation.

1. Prizes are the following:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Prize - ₱ 5,000 Cash + Medal + Certificate of Recognition
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize - ₱ 3,000 Cash + Medal + Certification of Recognition
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize - ₱ 2,000 Cash + Medal + certificate of Recognition
- 4th & 5th Place - Consolation of P1,000 each

2. There are also entrance discounts to those winners who will enroll at T.I.P.

- 1st Place- 100% discount on Tuition Fee for 1 semester
- 2nd Place- 75% discount on Tuition Fee for 1 semester
- 3rd Place- 50% discount on Tuition Fee for 1 semester


