IT WIZARDS: QUIZ BEE COMPETITION RULES AND MECHANICS

Objectives:

- To promote academic excellence and enhance students' knowledge and critical thinking skills.
- To encourage healthy competition among schools and motivate students to strive for excellence.
- To provide a platform for students to showcase their talents and represent their schools in an intellectual competition.

GUIDELINES:

- The competition is open to students currently enrolled in any Technological Institute of the Philippines invited school this S.Y. 2022-2023.
- 2. Participants must be in Grade 11 and 12.
- 3. Each school should send three (3) participants.
- Each school must register their team through an online registration form provided by the College of Computer Studies - TIP Manila. Unable to register online will not be accepted to the competition.

- 5. Registration must include the names of the three participants, the name of the school, and the contact information of the school representative.
- Registration deadline is until April 31, 2023. Unable to register before the deadline will
 not be accepted to the competition.
- 7. The Quizbee competition will consist of three rounds: Easy, Medium and Difficult Rounds.
- 8. Easy round will have **15 questions**, Medium round will have **10 questions** and; the Difficult round will have **5 questions**.
- 9. Participants will have ten (10) seconds to answer the Easy and Medium. Five (5) seconds will be provided to answer the Difficult question.
- 10. Each correct answer will earn one (1) point for Easy, three (3) points for Medium, and five (5) points for Difficult.
- 11. In case of a tie, another round of questions will be conducted.
- 12. In raising a protest, any member of the team must raise his/her right hand before the quizmaster reads the next question. Failure to do so would mean forfeiture of the right to protest and acceptance of the answer/s given.
- 13. The competition will be held at P. Casal PE Center inside Technological Institute of the Philippines Manila Campus.
- 14. The exact date and time of the competition will be on May 3, 2023 | 1:00 PM.
- 15. Participants **must arrive at least 30 minutes** before the program starts. Late participants will not be entertained in the competition.
