

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List of Activities and Mechanics

Conference Proper

A. Description

 This is the main event of PHIMUN where the delegates will be divided into their respective committees to discuss and debate upon the topics provided by the organizers. It is expected from the sessions to have each committee produce resolution/s about their designated issues. In the evening, there will be a social night where delegates can get to know each other more.

B. Mechanics

- Registrants are assigned a specific Member State and committee before the conference proper. The six committees are: United Nations General Assembly, United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, United Nations Security Council, International Court of Justice, United Nations Children's Fund, and the International Monetary Fund.
- Before the conference, each delegate is expected to write a position paper which reflects their Member State's stance and proposed solutions. They may include them in their resolutions during the conference proper.
- During the conference proper, delegates will act as diplomats representing their assigned Member State in the United Nations, and declare themselves present or present and voting during the roll call.
- Delegates must participate in speeches, discuss the agenda for the topic, and partake in moderated and unmoderated discussions with other delegates regarding the issue at hand.
- At the end of the conference, delegates must be able to create draft resolutions which address the agenda topic, with solutions that are representative of the Member States' stances and the mandate of the assigned committee.
- Delegates must vote on the draft resolutions presented to the committee, and the passed resolutions must be presented during the plenary session attended by delegates from all committees.
- Exemplary delegates who have actively participated in the conference and embodied their Member States' stances while displaying mastery of the issues and procedure will be recognized by the Dais through the Best Delegate and Honorable Mention awards.

C. Awards

- Best Position Paper This is given to the delegates that have written exemplary position papers which accurately represent their nation's stance on the topic and provide realistic and detailed solutions to the issues at hand. The rubric is as follows:
 - a) Content and Development: The report presents empirical evidence and demonstrates strong critical thinking and

- b) Organization: The paper takes a firm, well-defined stance. -20%
- c) Structure: The structure of the paper is clear and easy to follow. - 15%
- d) Format: The content follows the rules of grammar, usage, punctuation, and spelling. - 5%
- Best Delegate One delegate from each committee will receive this award at the end of the conference to recognize the outstanding performance of the delegate during the committee sessions.
- 3. Honorable Mention Two delegates from each committee will receive this award at the end of the conference to recognize the outstanding performance of the delegate during the committee sessions. The following shall be primary considerations in awarding the Best Delegate and Honorable Mention:
 - a) The delegate/s exhibited awareness of the matters at hand, including their background, committee actions, and points to be considered.
 - b) The delegate/s demonstrated knowledge of their country's foreign policy and its practical application to the committee's stances and actions (not applicable for delegates to the ICC).
 - c) The delegate/s actively participated in discussions and debates with other delegates.
 - d) The delegate/s showcased diplomatic and public speaking abilities.
 - e) The delegate/s contributed significantly to the resolution-making process.
 - f) The delegate/s displayed command of the Rules of Procedure.
- Best Group Delegation This is awarded to a group of delegates belonging to one school or university who have collectively demonstrated an excellent performance during the conference.
 - a) The number of votes for each delegation is totaled and divided by the product of the number of committees in which that delegation is represented times the number of sessions (e.g. 5 committees * 8 sessions = 40 opportunities to be recognized as a top delegation in a session).
 - b) Delegates from different committees who meet the criteria above (see Best Delegate criteria) and belong to one delegation are recognized as Best Group Delegation.
 - c) The school which the delegates represent will be recognized.

II. Humanitarian Forum

A. Description

One of the first events of PHIMUN, the Humanitarian Forum gives the
delegates an opportunity to listen to a celebrated speaker who is
prominent in their work and contribution in the world of diplomacy and
foreign service. The speaker shall endeavor to raise cognizance
regarding their profession especially to delegates who are interested

careers. The speaker shall also discuss international issues addressed in the theme of the conference, and encourage and motivate the delegates to create and provide solutions to these problems through speeches, debate, and resolution-making in the conference. Afterwards, the delegates shall be invited to an open forum, where they can add their insights or ask the speaker questions related to the talk.

III. PHIMUN Gala and Cultural Night

A. Description

This is the closing event of the conference wherein delegates get to
experience a diplomatic dinner filled with cultural performances. There
will be keynote speakers, as well as the orientation for the house rules
and announcements for the committee sessions. Delegates are also
encouraged to wear the national costumes of their represented
countries to the gala night to celebrate cultural diversity and
international camaraderie.

IV. Advocacy Fair

A. Description

1. Simultaneous with the conference proper registration and the Humanitarian Forum, the Advocacy Fair is a platform for conference participants to be exposed to and learn about international organizations and non-government organizations (NGOs) who are working towards the legislation of policy and implementation of projects that benefit local communities and marginalized sectors. These firms will have a chance to present to the conference participants who the former is, what they do, and how the various opportunities they offer collaborate with the youth.

V. Art for Humanity

A. Description

1. The Art for Humanity is a digital poster making project open on a voluntary basis to conference participants. It intends on capturing the artistic prowess of participants in using digital art as a medium to convey the theme of PHIMUN 2023. During the conference proper, poster submissions will be printed and displayed around the venue to mimic an art gallery for public viewing. Submissions will also be subject to evaluation by a panel of judges for awarding. Participants will be able to take their printed posters home after the conference.

B. Mechanics

- The artwork to be submitted must be any form of still art-cartoon, painting, poster, sketch, mixed media art, etc.
- Artworks must be in line with the theme of PHIMUN 2023, "Ensuring Holistic Human Security for Future Generations."
- 3 Artworks will be printed in and displayed during the Conference

- Artworks are expected to be creative original artwork and ideas. The use of artificial intelligence is strictly prohibited.
- The PHIMUN Secretariat reserves the right to disqualify any participant who fails to comply with the project's mechanics.

C. Awards

- Best Artwork This is given to the participant whose artwork receives the highest accumulated grade based on the following criteria:
 - a) Relevance (30%)
 - b) Creativity and Uniqueness (20%)
 - c) Professional and Aesthetic Quality (30%)
 - d) Public Vote (20%)
- People's Choice Award This is given to the participant whose artwork receives the highest number of votes from the public.

Rationale and General Description of the Activity

The Philippine International Model United Nations (PHIMUN) is an international Model UN Conference in the Philippines that is open to all senior high school students, undergraduate students, and graduate students. Following this year's theme: Ensuring Holistic Human Security for Future Generations, this conference aims to highlight pressing world issues that threaten the very future of humanity in various aspects of society, such as education, energy, finance, and crime. In line with such, the conference will simulate the United Nations General Assembly, United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, United Nations Security Council, International Court of Justice, United Nations Children's Fund, and the International Monetary Fund.

Specific Objectives of the Activity

PHIMUN 2023 aspires to:

- (1) simulate the actual proceedings in the United Nations by conducting their sessions through their major organs, subsidiary bodies, and specialized agencies;
- (2) to cultivate the minds of future diplomats engaging them in multinational discussions of global issues leading to consensual resolutions; and lastly,
- (3) to exhibit the Philippine culture and traditions through numerous endeavors.
