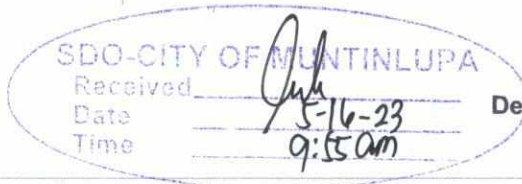

EVENT DESCRIPTION:

The proposed program will not only showcase the talents and skills of the youths but will also promote our relationship with our LGUs, most importantly, with School Division Offices, as well as help promote the regional office’s official Facebook Page.

STATEMENT OF MERIT:

- To promote the celebration of the Month of the Ocean
- To raise awareness on its theme “Sustainably Feed the Global Population”
- To strengthen partnership with Schools Division Office from each LGU in NCR
- To engage the youth in promoting environmental awareness through their talents

MECHANICS:

- All MEOs shall coordinate with their respective School Division Offices (SDOs) to assure the participation of all LGUs in the contest.
- Each School Division Office (SDO) shall have **one representative group composed of three students.**
- The contest shall be conducted in a venue, within Metro Manila.
- Transportation of the groups shall be arranged by the SDOs.
- Art materials will be provided by the DENR-NCR including:
 - Poster Board (30” X 40”)
 - BGI-WAP Pastel Colors
 - Pencils
 - Mong Marte Brush Set (2 sets per group)
- Participants may bring and use their own materials.
- The participants will be given a maximum of 2 hours to finish their artwork:
- Participants shall only use the provided illustration board.
- Participants shall have a short write-up (maximum of 100 words) about their artwork.
- The artworks shall remain the property of their respective artists. However, participation in this contest implies permission to DENR-NCR to use their artworks for, but not limited to social media posting, I.E.C campaign, among others. Attributions shall be made to the artists.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

<p>Relevance to the Theme The poster should effectively convey the theme "Sustainably feed the global population" and communicate a clear message to the viewers. The relevance of the theme that shall be integrated with the Manila Bay Rehabilitation Program should be given significant weight, as it is the main objective of the contest.</p>	30%
<p>Creativity and Originality The poster should demonstrate creativity and originality in the design and use of visual elements. The design should be eye-catching and unique, and should not appear to be copied or plagiarized. Consideration will be given to works that reflect their LGU's identity.</p>	25%
<p>Use of Colors and Visual Elements The poster should effectively use color and other visual elements to enhance the design and convey the intended message. The use of color should be appropriate and effective in conveying the intended message.</p>	25%
<p>Overall Impact The poster should make a strong overall impact on the viewer, leaving a lasting impression and effectively communicating the intended message.</p>	10%
<p>Write-Up The short write-up should convey a message that is relevant to the contest's theme or topic and the artwork of the contestant.</p>	10%
