

SUBJECT: INVITATION: PROPOSAL SUBMISSIONS TO THE 2023 ASIAN TRY ZERO G COMPETITION (COUNTRY LEVEL)

Dear Dr. Cabral:

We are pleased to inform you that the Philippine Space Agency is now accepting entries for the above event. The competition is one of the activities under the Kibo -Asian Beneficial Collaboration program that aims to expand the use of the Kibo module on the International Space Station (ISS) by conducting selected experiments from the Asia Pacific region.

For 2023, two categories were identified for the competition:

- Category A: Physics Experiments
 - Simple physics experiments, that can be demonstrated to confirm physical phenomena. It can be performed using items already available on Kibo or using small items that can be newly launched into the ISS. Kindly refer to the guidelines for more details.
- Category B: Exercise in Space

On-board exercises for astronauts:

- A unique body movement which cannot be done on the ground but can be done in space.
- Body movement and postures which can be an exercise under microgravity, yet easily done on Earth. (e.g., Squatting can be easily done on Earth, but it may be difficult in space.)

Students, up to the post graduate level, are welcome to submit proposals through this link: <u>https://bit.ly/ATZG2023</u>. Deadline is **31 May 2023**.

Selected entries will be performed in a zero-gravity environment by a Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency (JAXA) astronaut in the Kibo module of the ISS.
