The Red Cross Youth Department of Rizal Chapter will be conducting the **Youth Volunteer Orientation Module (YVOM) Facilitators Workshop** on June 26-30, 2023 at the Philippine Red Cross Rizal Chapter Training Hall located at 611 Shaw Blvd., Kapitolyo, Pasig City. This is an intensive 5- day training which aims to prepare the youth to become future Red Cross Youth Facilitators who will aid in the conduct of Youth Volunteer Orientation Module course, one of the entrypoint trainings for Red Cross Youth which is conducted on different Red Cross Youth Councils. The said training will equip the interested Red Cross Youth volunteers with ages ranging from 16-30 years old with the necessary knowledge and skills in conducting YVOM trainings which include the following but are not limited to: Levelling Off, Red Cross Movement, Red Cross Youth, Youth as Agents of Behavioral Change Framework, and Teaching Strategies.

YOUTH VOLUNTEER ORIENTATION MODULE FACILITATORS' WORKSHOP

RATIONALE

The Red Cross Youth, one of the six major services of Philippine Red Cross, aims to enhance the leadership skills of the youth through the conduct of different programs, projects, and activities that are catered towards children, adolescents, and youth of different councils and communities.

The Youth Volunteer Orientation Module (YVOM) Facilitators' Workshop is an intensive 5-day upscale training from the previously conducted activity of the same name which aims to prepare the youth to become future Red Cross Youth Facilitators which together with the Red Cross Youth Trainers spearhead the conduct of Youth Volunteer Orientation Module course conducted by different Red Cross Youth Councils. The said training will equip the participants with the necessary knowledge and skills in conducting YVOM trainings which include the following but are not limited to: Levelling Off, Red Cross Movement, Red Cross Youth, Youth as Agents of Behavioral Change Framework, and Teaching Strategies.

OBJECTIVES

General Objective

- To produce competent facilitators which are equipped with the necessary knowledge and skills which will enable them to conduct YVOM trainings in various Red Cross Youth councils.

Specific Objectives

- Enhance the mastery of the participants in the core modules of the Youth Volunteer Orientation Module such as the conduct of Levelling Off activities, Red Cross Movement and Red Cross Youth.
- Train and produce at least 14 new RCY facilitators across different branches of Rizal Chapter.

5. A Red Cross Youth member whose ages range from 16-30 years old.
