This is through intensifying not only the recruitment of Red Cross Youth members, but most especially the RCY programs being offered all-year round for the youth.

In line with the said objective, PRC Rizal Red Cross Youth will be having the 2023 Search for Gawad Kabataan, Most Promising Red Cross Youth Leader (MPRCYL), and Most Outstanding Rizal Red Cross Youth Leader (MORRCYL) Awardees and will focus on their transformational initiatives to make changes in their community. The aim of this activity is to recognize the valuable contributions and efforts of the youth in the organization by giving awards and recognition to all its outstanding volunteers. The whole program will run from May 31 2023 to July 8, 2023 with interviews, screenings and examinations to be conducted to ensure fairness and credibility for its search for leadership and excellence.

Relative thereto, we are humbly asking for your support on the aforementioned activity and dates by providing a Memorandum for this activity. We believe that we can amplify the objective of youth empowerment by highlighting their invaluable service to their community, council, and fellow youth.

GUIDELINES FOR 2023 GAWAD KABATAAN, MOST PROMISING RED CROSS YOUTH LEADERS (MPRCYL) AND MOST OUTSTANDING RIZAL RED CROSS YOUTH LEADERS (MORRCYL)

RATIONALE

The Philippine Red Cross recruits, trains, and gives opportunities to youth volunteers through the various programs and activities of its Red Cross Youth (RCY) service. The RCY organizes youth councils in schools and communities to allow members to plan and implement Red Cross activities as an organized group. The success of each RCY council depends on the leadership of its officers and support of each member. To encourage RCY members to be actively involved in all RCY programs, activities, and projects, the Red Cross Youth gives recognition to its outstanding volunteers. The Red Cross Youth believes that by recognizing outstanding RCY members, all Red Cross Youth Councils will be inspired to organize RCY activities and implement RCY programs to achieve distinction.

The 2023 Search for Gawad Kabataan, MPRCYL and MORRCYL Awardees focuses on recognizing the outstanding youth who showcase excellence in their communities. This year highlights the individuals who challenged the norms by stepping up and transforming advocacy into action. As we bounce back and move to the new normal, it is important that we adapt to the changes and begin taking actions regardless of their challenges, boundaries, and hardships.

The 2023 Search consists of two (2) awards. First, the Gawad Kabataan Award, which is nominated by the RCY Adviser to represent the Council in the Branch Level, and the Most Outstanding Rizal Red Cross Youth Leader (for Senior, Senior Plus, College, and Community RCY) or the Most Promising Rizal Red Cross Youth Leader (for Junior Red Cross), has passed the requirements set by the Gawad Kabataan and is nominated by their respective CSR-RCY to represent their Branch in the Chapter Level.

The award shall be bestowed to active Red Cross Youth Volunteers under the jurisdiction of Rizal Chapter. The recipients should have also contributed to the management and sustenance of their respective Red Cross Youth Councils.

OBJECTIVE

Recognize active and commendable Red Cross Youth volunteers who have achieved the required level of excellence in service delivery and have made an impact in their respective school or community through their active involvement with the PRC and other organizations.

NOMINATION FOR THE AWARDS

Nominations for the Gawad Kabataan should only be made by their respective Red Cross Youth Advisers duly signed by their respective Principals/OICs (School) or Barangay Chairman (Community). Those who were chosen for the Gawad Kabataan Award are automatically nominated for the Most Outstanding Rizal Red Cross Youth Leader in Senior, Senior Plus, College, and Community Red Cross Youth Category and the Most Promising Rizal Red Cross Youth Leader for Junior Red Cross.

LIST OF AWARDS

- Gawad Kabataan Award Branch Level Award nominated by the RCY Adviser for Junior, Senior, Senior Plus, College, and Community Red Cross Youth Members.
- Most Promising Red Cross Youth Leader Chapter Level award for Junior Red Cross Members.
- Most Outstanding Rizal Red Cross Youth Leader Chapter Level award for Senior, Senior Plus, College, and Community Red Cross Youth members.

QUALIFICATIONS OF PROSPECTIVE NOMINEES

All Red Cross Youth members and volunteers must possess the following qualifications:

- · A bonafide Red Cross Youth Member.
- A Filipino resident with good humanitarian values and character.
- · Can express themselves fluently in English and/or Filipino.
- Active in the service delivery of the different PRC Services especially in Red Cross Youth for at least 2 years.
- Must not be convicted of any form of crime.
- Belongs to a recognized, active, and sustainable RCY Council and has participated in various Red Cross activities of the Rizal Chapter.

REQUIREMENTS FOR 2023 GAWAD KABATAAN

All Red Cross Youth members and volunteers who would express their interest to join the search for awardees shall submit the following requirements:

- 1. Filled out and signed Official Nomination Form
- 2. Letter of Recommendation from the RCY Adviser
- 3. Photocopy of LDP Certificate
- 4. 2 pieces 2x2 ID Picture
- 5. RCY Accomplishment Report Form
- 6. Volunteer Accomplishment Form for Other Organizational Involvements
 - Highlight at least one (1) most significant accomplishment from any RCY or Non-RCY activities.

7. Project Proposal

For Senior, Senior Plus, College and Community Red Cross Youth:

- The Project Proposal shall include all the details and may be written in either English or Filipino.
- Can be new or part of sustainability in an existing project, as long as it is written in an original way.
- Shall focus on one of the following themes and be duly accomplished in three (3) copies.
 - a. Community Health
 - b. Climate Change
 - c. Education
 - d. Mental and Social Well-being

8. Essay

For Junior Red Cross:

- The essay may be written in either pure English or Filipino (not both)
- Minimum of 200, and maximum of 500-word count.
- The essay will be written on-the-spot.
- Theme: What type of changes do you want to see in your community and how can you take part to achieve it?

For Senior, Senior Plus, College and Community Red Cross Youth:

- The essay may be written in either pure English or Filipino (not both)
- Minimum of 500, and maximum of 1000-word count.
- · The essay will be written on-the-spot.
- Theme:
 - a. What do you think is the most challenging part of being a youth and how can it be your tool to make transformative changes in your community?
 - b. What do you think is the best aspect of being a youth and how can it be your tool to make transformative changes in your community?
 - c. "Young people should be at the forefront of global change and innovation. Empowered, they can be key agents for development and peace. If, however, they are left on society's margins, all of us will be impoverished." As a youth volunteer facing challenges of today, how can you take part in making transformative solutions in your community to envision a better future?

SCREENING AND SELECTION PROCESS

There will be three (3) levels of selection namely:

1. Council Level

- The Red Cross Youth Adviser can nominate all interested applicants for the Gawad Kabataan Awardee.
- Nominees will be given a copy of the Official Nomination Form from the RCY Adviser and nominees must submit the requirements on time.

2. Branch Level

- CSR-RCY must receive all nominations with complete requirements.
- CSR-RCY will facilitate the examination provided by the Rizal Chapter.
- Qualified nominees will be notified for an interview at Rizal Chapter.

3. Chapter Level

- Nominees who will get at least 85% from the result of interview and examination will receive the Gawad Kabataan Award and will also proceed to the next level.
- Finalists of Gawad Kabataan from different branches will proceed to the next level of interview and examination.
- MORRCYL Finalists who will get at least 88% will receive the Most Promising Rizal Red Cross Youth Leader or Most Outstanding Rizal Red Cross Youth Leader.
- The Most Promising Rizal Red Cross Youth Leader and Most Outstanding Rizal Red Cross Youth leader will be selected as a result of the interview including their knowledge, skills, and attitude.
