Greetings!

Our organization has been in partnership with DepEd Muntinlupa since 2004. One of our programs, Elementary and High School Values Education Class (EHSVEC), aims to work hand in hand with schools toward the accomplishment of DepEd's Core Values: Maka-Diyos, Makatao, Makakalikasan, and Makabansa.

Our curriculum, *Mamuhay Nang Tama*, is in line with DepEd's Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP) curriculum and is an excellent supplement to lessons covering EsP MELCs. As such, EHSVEC, which is only 20-30 minutes weekly per class, is usually taught during the Homeroom time once a week or any other slot most convenient to the school.

In addition, our EHSVEC teachers are also trained to conduct counseling and reading remediation since we believe that education must be holistic. Also, we have incorporated in our curriculum special lessons on mental health to help children and youth understand their situation and deal with it accordingly.

We have seen the impact of our program in many schools as far as the improvement of the behavior of children is concerned. Principals and teachers can testify to the positive change our partnership with them brought to their school community.

In this regard, we would like to seek your permission, Ma'am, to teach EHSVEC in schools in Muntinlupa City this coming SY 2023-2024. We assure you that this is FREE of any charges and we will do everything in our capacity so classes are not disrupted.
