The U.P. Child Development Center (UPCDC) is the laboratory school of the Department of Family Life and Child Development, UP College of Home Economics (CHE-FLCD). It offers 12 preschool classes catering to a total of 160 children aged 3 months up to 5 years. It promotes the holistic development of Filipino children through creative and developmentally appropriate learning experiences. One of the ways that the Center achieves this goal is by celebrating Book Week each year which also highlights the value of literacy in the early years.

Since 2018, our Department has partnered with the Department of Science and Technology-Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI) to develop children's storybooks that promote early Math and Science skills.
