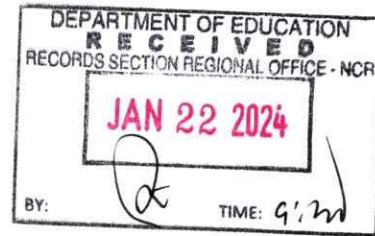



The Fulbright DAI program provides primary and secondary teachers/staff with a unique opportunity to develop greater expertise in their subject areas, enhance their teaching skills, increase their knowledge about the United States, and complete an individual or group project. The Application period for the Fulbright DAI began on December 15, 2023 and will end on April 30, 2024.

In connection with this program, I am writing to request your assistance in disseminating information about the Fulbright DAI and other scholarship programs by encouraging eligible/potential faculty members and staff who are looking for educational opportunities in the United States and are committed to serve and return to our country upon completion of their Fulbright DAI grant. The Fulbright DAI program is eligible for primary and secondary school teachers with five or more years of classroom experience who hold full-time teaching positions in all subjects. Library media specialists, guidance counselors, curriculum specialists, special education coordinators, administrators and other educators who work directly with primary and/or secondary students in a primary or secondary school that serves a primarily local (not expatriate) population at least fifty percent of their time and teacher trainers may also apply to the program.

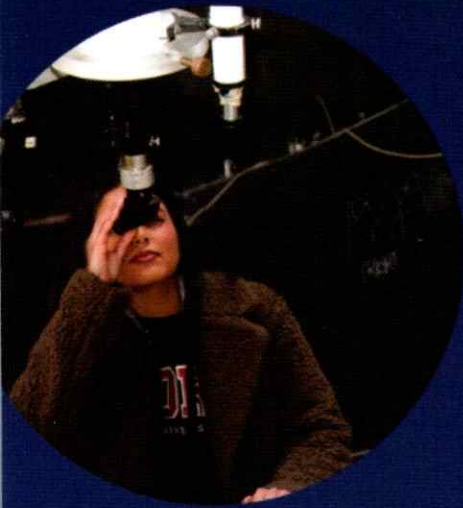

SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS FOR FILIPINOS

Philippine-American Educational (PAEF), also referred to as the Fulbright Commission in the Philippines, is a binational commission that administers the prestigious Fulbright Program, Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program, and Global Undergraduate Exchange Program.



FULBRIGHT FOREIGN STUDENT PROGRAM

Enables Filipinos to study at the graduate level (Master's or Doctoral) and conduct non-degree doctoral dissertation research in the United States.



FULBRIGHT ADVANCED RESEARCH AND UNIVERSITY LECTURING PROGRAM

Also called the Fulbright Visiting Scholar Program is for researchers and professors for the implementation of their own research projects at U.S. universities, non-profit research institutes and some government institutions.



FULBRIGHT U.S.-ASEAN VISITING SCHOLAR PROGRAM

An initiative to deepen the people-to-people engagement and strengthen our educational ties with the ten member nations of ASEAN open to university faculty, government officials, and professional staff of the private sector, think tanks, and other NGOs in the ASEAN member states.



HUBERT H. HUMPHREY FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

This ten-month Fellowship program is offered to mid-career professionals with a proven track of leadership, a public service commitment, and the capacity to take full advantage of a self-defined program of independent non-degree study at a leading U.S. university.



FULBRIGHT FOREIGN LANGUAGE TEACHING ASSISTANT (FLTA) PROGRAM

Provides young teachers of English [based outside of Metro Manila] as a Foreign Language opportunity to refine their teaching skills and broaden their knowledge of American cultures and customs while strengthening the instruction of foreign languages at colleges and universities in the United States.



FULBRIGHT DISTINGUISHED AWARDS IN TEACHING PROGRAM FOR INTERNATIONAL TEACHERS (FULBRIGHT DAI)

Brings international primary and secondary teachers to the United States for a semester-long program to pursue individual or group projects, take courses for professional development at a host university, observe, and share their expertise with U.S. colleagues.



GLOBAL UNDERGRADUATE EXCHANGE PROGRAM (GLOBAL UGRAD)

Also known as the Global UGRAD Program provides one (1) semester scholarship to outstanding undergraduate students from around the world for non-degree full-time study combined with community service, professional development, and cultural enrichment.
