As presented on our last meeting in 2023, our team would like to work with you on an exciting new project that has been cascaded by the National Council on Disability Affairs entitled "IT Challenge for Youth with Disabilities". This is a prequel to the National and the International Competitions through the Global IT Challenge for Youths with Disabilities held in foreign lands such as South Korea and Dubai.

We are ecstatic to see you all in action in ensuring inclusive education for learners with disability together with your students and teachers.

Since this will be a first in Muntinlupa and not a lot has heard about it, we'd like to summarize this competition to you and your team:

The Global IT Challenge for Youth with Disabilities (GITC) is a project to strengthen the ICT capabilities of youth with disabilities, establish the foundation for social advancement, and improve the awareness of digital accessibility for youth with disabilities. The Philippines is a yearly competitor in this event thus we are looking for and would like to develop IT YWD Athletes to send to this competition. The GITC is divided into 6 categories namely:

ETool (MS Powerpoint)

ETool (Excel)

eLifeMap – Internet Searching

eContent (Content Creation – Video)

eCreative_Smart Car (Zumi Car Programming)

eCreative IoT (Electronics Assembly and Arduino Programming)

As you may notice, these are important skills for the youth even without disabilities. These are essential components of daily life used in the education setting or workplace. These life-skills are society-expected rudiments for us to function effectively through modern technology.



THE EVENTS IN THE COMPETITION

For the 1st Mayor Ruffy Biazon (MRB) IT Challenge, we would like to only implement the following 3 categories:

- ETool (MS Powerpoint)**
- ETool (Excel)**
- eLifeMap – Internet Searching**

THE TEAMS

There will be **10 Teams** and will be consisted of **3 entities (1 SPED Student, 1 Student Buddy (Enrolled SDO – Regular Upper Classman, CDM or PLMUN Student, 14 to 20 Years old with Disability (Blind, Physical, Deaf/ Hard of Hearing, Learning, Intellectual) 1 Teacher Coach from SDO-PLMUN-CDM)**. The Schools Division Office will assess their SPED Students who may be able to participate in this event and create a final roster of their participants. PLMUN and CDM Students / Teachers will also be identified. They shall be selected and formally endorsed (thru a signed letter of the SDO Head / PLMUN President / CDM President) to Muntinlupa PDAO.

THE RULES

The deciding metrics for **ETool Excel, Powerpoint and eLifeMap** are gameplay time (20%) and score count (80%). There will only be 10 Questions per event. If there is a tie, there will be a clincher round and the player who has the fastest time, and the least number of errors will win.

Rubric: Time Points (20%) + Score (80%) = Total Category Score (100%)

Time 20% (20 mins per Category – ETool Excel, ETool Powerpoint and eLifeMap only)

Task Accomplished in 20 mins (maximum time) = 1 Point

- 19 mins = 2 points
- 18 mins = 3 points
- 17 mins = 4 points
- 16 mins = 5 points
- 15 mins = 6 points
- 14 mins = 7 points
- 13 mins = 8 points
- 12 mins = 9 points
- 11 mins = 10 points
- 10 mins = 11 points
- 9 mins = 12 points
- 8 mins = 13 points
- 7 mins = 14 points
- 6 mins = 15 points
- 5 mins = 16 points
- 4 mins = 17 points
- 3 mins = 18 points
- 2 mins = 19 points
- 1 mins = 20 points

Score 80% (Number of Correctly Answered Items - ETool Excel, ETool Powerpoint and eLifeMap only)

Example: Player 1 Test Score: 9/10 (multiply by 8 to get Category Score)
Category Score = 72

Sample Computation: eTool Excel
Player 1 got 9/10 and finished 11 mins
Category Score = 72

THE TRAINING

Muntinlupa PDAO will hold a 1 day meet and greet / training event to initially form the 10 Teams and provide more insight regarding this contest. The organizers will randomly sort the SPED students to the already in tandem Teacher Coach and Student Buddy / per school (SDO/CDM/PLMUN) They will be provided with an orientation to the competition by MIS and PDAO. Laptops and cellphones to be used in this 1 day training will be provided by the participants (Parents of YWD, SDO, PLMUN, CDM). 1 Laptop and 1 Cellphone per team will be required. The participants can train by themselves but there will be no further support and accountability from the organizers outside of the said 1 day training.

THE PRIZES

The Players with the highest Total IT Challenge Scores will receive cash prizes and gift items from the City Government of Muntinlupa. They are as follows:
