Greetings from the Second Congressional Commission on Education (EDCOM II).

In support of the mandate of the Second Congressional Commission on Education (EDCOM II) to undertake a comprehensive national assessment and evaluation of the performance of the Philippine education sector, the University of the Philippines President Edgardo J. Angara (UPPEJA) Fellowship Award, a legacy of Senator Edgardo J. Angara, was revived last September 2023 to conduct research on education reform based on the priority areas identified by the Commission.

Among the UPPEJA research studies, focused on enabling transformation in basic education through systems, leadership, and culture, are titled "Understanding Systems, Creative Strategies, and Enabling Leadership" by Dr. Ma. 
