



The 2024 International Conference of Living Values Education will focus on a Values-Based Atmosphere and Values-driven leadership. Schools are encouraged to continuously assess the need for mental health intervention and psychosocial support, with strengthened referral systems to meet these needs.

As values must be "caught" and "taught," the adults involved are integral to the program's success, for young people learn best by example and are most receptive when what is shared is experienced. Establishing a values-based atmosphere, a culture of peace, caring, and respect, is essential for optimal exploration and development. Such a student-centered environment naturally enhances learning, as relationships based on trust, caring, and respect positively affect motivation, creativity, and affective and cognitive development.

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
