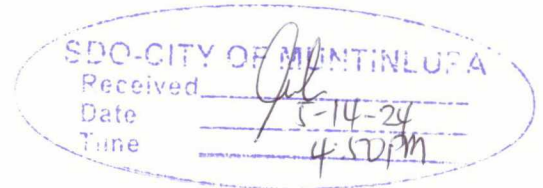



SUBJECT : Scouts for Marine Conservation Conference

1. We are pleased to announce the invitation of the National Eagle Scouts Association of the Philippines (NESAPh) in partnership and collaboration with the Taguig City Council, BSP, to co-host and organize the **1st Scouts for Marine Conservation Conference**, on **08 June 2024**, at the **Lakeshore Hall, City of Taguig** in observance and celebration of the **2024 World Ocean's Day**, to promote, protect and conserve Marine Biodiversity including our seas and oceans.
2. The event is expected to host at least 400 Scouts, Rovers and Leaders from various Councils in the Region through open invitation using an Online Pre-registration Platform via Google Forms. For interested Scouts, you may access the registration form using this link <https://bit.ly/SFMCCReg> with a very minimal **Conference Fee of Php 250.00** to defray the expenses on meals, souvenirs, conference materials, programmes and other administrative requirements of the event.

The conference is a whole day (8:00AM to 5:00PM) educational event filled with different interactive sessions and engaging discussion among Scouts, together with confirmed invited guests and resource persons from the Philippine Coast Guard, Philippine Coast Guard Auxiliary, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources – Biodiversity Management Bureau, and other NGOs and CSOs whose primary advocacy is to protect and conserve our marine biodiversity.
4. We believed that this undertaking is very timely, meaningful and relevant pursuant to the role of youth in taking positive actions to mitigate the impact of global warming and climate change.
