6th IWPG International Loving-Peace Art Competition Preliminaries

Dear Family of Peace,

We sincerely thank for your hard work for the dreams and hopes of children in you region and we wish for the endless development of your school.

1. Introduction of the IWPG

The International Women's Peace Group (IWPG) is an international peace organization that is in special consultative status with the UN ECOSOC. There are over 100 branches throughout 130 countries with headquarters in Seoul, South Korea. IWPG aims to improve the rights and interests of women around the world, is working internationally with the heart of a mother for the empowerment of women and is working to achieve peace that transcends nationality, ethnicity, and religion.

2. Introduction of the 6th International Loving-Peace Art Competition

Children and youth are the protagonists of the future era and the seeds that will lead world peace in the future. The 6th International Loving Peace Art Competition is being held to instill the hope for an end to war and world peace and to draw a concrete picture of the world of peace that will be achieved in the future. Since its establishment in 2013, the International Women's Peace Group(IWPG) has been working for the cessation of war and world peace for 10 years and has been hosting this competition since 2018 to a culture of peace.

3. Purpose

- To make children and youth, the agents of peace, aware of the importance of peace.
- To encourage parents to participate together to create a culture of peace empathized across generations and to spread this culture around the world.
- To allow students to imagine how to achieve the peace needed in the world and how peace can be achieved through this year's theme.

4. Goal

- Provide opportunities for children and youth around the world to participate in competitions.
- Motivate participants to take the lead in achieving peace as leaders of peace.
- Publish a catalog of the award-winning works so that works of peace remain as a permanent legacy of peace.
- Allow one to look for elements of peace around oneself that may have overlooked without knowing their importance.
- Serve as an opportunity to develop artistic sense, observation skills, and expressive skills.

- Serve as an international competition that provides an opportunity for youth to interact and communicate with peers from all over the world beyond their respective countries.
- Encourage participation from a wider range of countries to spread this competition, marking its 6th year.

The organization hopes that the students of your school can participate in the preliminary round on June 15, 2024 so that they can open a heart of peace through art.
