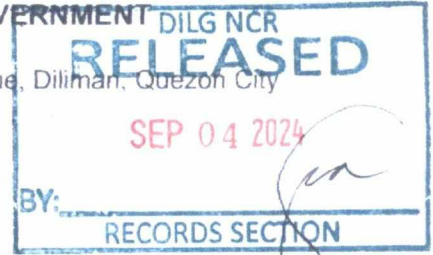

SUBJECT : NATIONAL TEACHER'S MONTH CELEBRATION 2024

DATE : AUGUST 29, 2024

REFERENCE : DILG Memorandum Circular 2024-118 with the same subject
