## ENCODING ON LEARNER INFORMATION SYSTEM (LIS) FOR BEGINNING OF SCHOOL YEAR (BOSY) 2024-2025

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisor, Curriculum Implementation Division OIC, Chief Education Supervisor, School Governance & Operations Division Public and Private Elementary and Secondary School Heads/OICs All Others Concerned

1. Attached is a DepEd Memorandum from the Office of the Undersecretary for Administration, dated September 11, 2024, on the above-captioned subject, the contents of which are self-explanatory.

2. To enable evidence-based policies, decision-making, programs, and projects in basic education, it is essential to collect accurate, timely, and correct data. This includes providing the official number of enrolled learners in the schools, which is gathered through the Department of Education's (DepEd) information systems, including the Learner Information System (LIS).

3. All private schools in the division commenced the encoding and updating of the learner's data in the LIS on June 10, 2024. In addition, public elementary and secondary schools and Alternative Learning System Community Learning Centers (ALS CLCs) launched the encoding and updating of the learner's data in the LIS on August 27, 2024. Furthermore, public schools shall strengthen the **Child Finding or Mapping activities in the locality** to guarantee that all school-age learners are enrolled in the school pursuant to DepEd Order No. 23, s. 2022, "Child Find Policy for Learners with Disabilities Towards Inclusive Education".

4. The deadline for the aforementioned LIS encoding and upgrading is on **October 31**, **2024**, and it will be applicable to all schools and ALS CLSs.

5. The Division Planning Officer (DPO) is responsible for overseeing the participation of all schools and CLCs and provide technical assistance to schools who are having trouble encoding their BOSY enrollment in the LIS.
