Participants: One (1) elementary student per school (Grades 4-6)

GENERAL RULES:

1. **Eligibility:** Each school may field one (1) contestant who will create a poster with a slogan (in Filipino) on a piece of illustration board provided by the organizer.
2. **Endorsement:** Each student-contestant must be officially endorsed by their School Principal or Director through the submission of a signed entry form, which should be delivered to DAPCO in person on or before November 12, 2024.
3. **Materials:** The Organizer (DAPCO) will provide all art materials and tools required for the contest. Contestants are not allowed to bring or use any additional materials.
4. **Dress Code:** Contestants must wear their official school P.E. uniform and bring their school ID. They should be accompanied by one official coach or teacher, who may not assist or approach the contestant during the contest proper.
5. **Clarifications:** Any questions regarding the contest theme will be addressed during the opening program, before the contest begins.
6. **Admission:** Participation is limited to 15 contestants, based on a "first-come, first-served" policy.
7. **Punctuality:** Latecomers will not be allowed to join once the contest has begun, so participants are advised to arrive on time.
8. **Time Limit:** Contestants will have a total of three (3) hours to complete their work.
9. **Board Replacement:** In case of significant damage to the surface of the illustration board, a replacement will be provided by the organizer, but only once.
10. **Ownership:** All entries will become the exclusive property of the Organizer and will be used for the 2026 DAPCO Calendar.

- **1:30 PM onwards** – Contest Proper

GENERAL RULES:

1. **Endorsement:** Each student-contestant must be officially endorsed by their School Principal or Director through the submission of a signed entry form, which must be submitted to DAPCO in person on or before **November 12, 2024**.
2. **Accompaniment:** Contestants must wear their school uniform and bring their school ID. They should be accompanied by one official coach or teacher.
3. **No Coaching:** Strictly no coaching will be allowed while the contest is in progress. Coaches must not interact with contestants during the quiz.
4. **Admission:** The contest is limited to 15 participants, based on a “first-come, first-served” policy.
5. **Materials Provided:** Contestants will be provided with a small board, chalk, and an eraser for writing their answers.
6. **Question Format:** All questions will be in **multiple-choice** format. Contestants need only write the letter (A, B, C, or D) corresponding to their chosen answer.

ELIMINATION AND SCORING PROCESS:

- **Elimination Round:**
 - There will be **10 questions** in this round.
 - The top **5 contestants** with the highest scores will proceed to the Semi-Final Round.
- **Semi-Final Round:**
 - There will be **10 questions** in this round.
 - Scores will reset to zero.
 - The top **3 contestants** will move on to the Final Round.
- **Final Round:**
 - There will be **5 questions** in this round.
 - Scores will again reset to zero.
 - Contestants will be ranked as **Champion, First Runner-Up, and Second Runner-Up** based on their final scores.
- **Tie-Breakers:**

In case of a tie in any round, additional questions will be asked until the tie is broken to determine ranking.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

- **Punctuality:** Participants must arrive on time. Late arrivals will not be entertained once the contest begins.
- **Disputes:** Any questions or disputes regarding a specific question or score must be raised immediately after that question has been asked, answered, and scored. Past questions and scores will not be revisited.
- **Final Decision:** The decision of the organizers is final and must be respected.

- Official Endorsement:** Participants must be officially endorsed by the School Principal through the entry form, submitted in person to DAPCO by **November 12, 2024**.
- Participant Limitation:** Only the first 12 groups will be accepted based on a "First Come, First Served" policy.
- Original Composition:**
 - The jingle must be an original work, both music and lyrics.
 - Lyrics should be in **Filipino**.
- Submission of Lyrics:**
 - Three (3)** printed copies of the lyrics (properly labeled with the school name) must be submitted on **Contest Day, November 21, 2024**.
- Content Guidelines:**
 - Lyrics must be free of obscene or offensive language.
- Time Limit:**
 - Each performance should be **2 to 5 minutes** long. Exceeding or failing to meet the time limit will result in a **5-point deduction**.
 - Groups will be given **5 minutes** for stage setup and breakdown. Exceeding this will incur a **5-point deduction**.
- Musical Accompaniment:**
 - Groups may use their own musical instruments or bring a **minus-one track** via USB.
 - No pre-recorded vocals** or jingle will be allowed.
- Clarity of Lyrics:**
 - The lyrics must be clearly heard and understood by the judges.
- Costumes/Props:**
 - Costumes and props are optional but must be managed within the time limits to avoid point deductions.
- Ownership of Entries:**
 - All submitted jingles will become the property of the Organizer.
- Punctuality:**
 - Participants must arrive on time. Late arrivals will not be allowed to compete.
