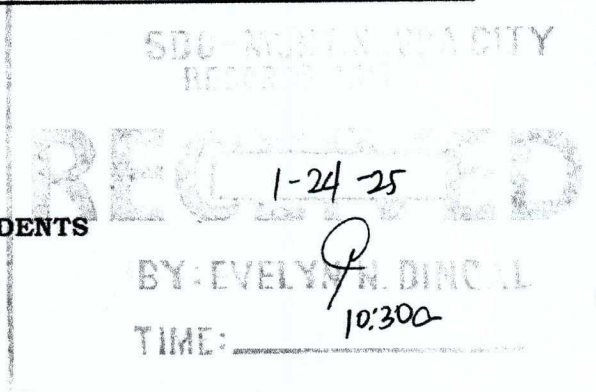

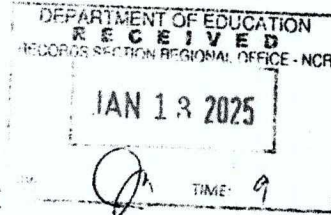

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

The Department of Education (DepEd), through the External Partnerships Service (EPS), is in discussion with Jobstreet by SEEK with regard to enhancing the career readiness and development among Senior High School (SHS) and Alternative Learning System (ALS) learners in the Philippines.
