Essay Writing Contest Guidelines and Mechanics

(English Category)

Theme: Muntinlupa City @ 30: Smart, Sustainable, Strong

Eligibility:

- 1. The contest is open to all bonafide Grade 7 to Grade 10 junior high school students and Grade 11 to Grade 12 senior high school learners enrolled in any Public and Private schools/institutions in the City of Muntinlupa.
- 2. One (1) entry is allowed to represent the junior high school, and another one (1) entry to represent the senior high school.

Entry Requirements:

- 1. The essay must be **original**, unpublished, and written solely by the contestant.
- 2. Essays must adhere to the theme provided.
- 3. Word count: Minimum of 500 words, maximum of 700 words.

Submission Details:

- 1. Deadline: February 12, 2025 (on the Day of the contest)
- 2. Submit entries to the Lead Person
- 3. Each submission must include a cover page with the following details:
 - Contestant's full name
 - Grade and section
 - Contact information
 - Title of the essay

Contest Mechanics:

- 1. The contest will be held on February 12, 2025, at 8:00 AM, at the 4th floor Activity Center of the Schools Division Office of Muntinlupa.
- 2. The essay topic will be announced at the start of the contest.

- 3. No prior preparation is allowed.
- 4. Each participant may submit only one entry.
- 5. Plagiarism will result in automatic disqualification.
- 6. Essays must be handwritten on standard paper size. Use legible handwriting.
- 7. Contestants will be given a pen/pencil and paper. **No outside materials** (e.g., notes, internet access) are allowed.
- 8. Essays will be judged based on originality, relevance to the topic, coherence, clarity, language style, and adherence to instructions.
- 9. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.
- 10. The rights of the submitted materials will automatically belong to the City Government of Muntinlupa.
- 11. Winners will be announced in the last week of February.

Criteria for Judging

- 1. Content and Relevance (40%)
 - Relevance to the topic
 - Depth of ideas and arguments
 - Creativity and originality
 - o Uniqueness, emotional resonance, and ability to engage the reader.
- 2. Organization and Coherence (20%)
 - Clear introduction, body, and conclusion
 - Logical flow of ideas and coherence between paragraphs

3. Clarity and Language Style (20%)

- Clear and concise expression
- Correct grammar, spelling, and punctuation
- 4. Critical Thinking (15%)
 - Ability to analyze, evaluate, and provide insightful perspectives

5. Adherence to Instructions (5%)

o Following the time limit and formatting guidelines

Tema: Muntinlupa City @ 30: Smart, Strong, Sustainable

Kwalipikasyon:

- 1. Ang patimpalak ay bukas para sa lahat ng mag-aaral ng Grade 7 hanggang Grade 10 junior high school at Grade 11 hanggang Grade 12 senior high school na naka-enroll sa alinmang pampubliko at pribadong paaralan/institusyon sa Lungsod ng Muntinlupa.
- 2. Isang kalahok lamang ang papayagan na mag representa sa junior high school, at isang kalahok din para sa senior high school sa bawat paaralan.

Kinakailangan sa Paglahok:

- 1. Ang sanaysay ay **dapat orihinal**, hindi pa nailathala, at isinulat lamang ng kalahok.
- 2. Ang sanaysay ay dapat sumunod sa ibinigay na tema.
- 3. Bilang ng mga salita: Minimum na 500 salita, maximum na 700 salita.

 - Pamagat ng sanaysay

Panuntunan ng Paligsahan:

- 1. Gaganapin ang patimpalak sa ika-12 ng Pebrero sa taong kasalukuyan ng ika-8:00 ng umaga, sa 4th floor Activity Center ng Schools Division Office of Muntinlupa.
- 2. Ang paksa ng sanaysay ay iaanunsyo sa simula ng patimpalak.

- 3. Hindi pahihintulutan ang paghahanda bago ang patimpalak.
- 4. Ang bawat kalahok ay maaaring magsumite ng isang sanaysay lamang.
- 5. Ang plagiarism ay magreresulta sa awtomatikong diskwalipikasyon.
- 6. Ang sanaysay ay dapat nakasulat-kamay sa karaniwang sukat ng papel. Gumamit ng mababasang sulat-kamay."
- 7. Ang kalahok ay bibigyan ng panulat at papel. **Hindi pahihintulutan ang mga panlabas na materyales** (e.g., notes, internet access).
- 8. Ang sanaysay ay huhusgahan batay sa orihinalidad, kaugnayan sa paksa, pagkakaugnay-ugnay, kalinawan, estilo ng wika, at pagsunod sa mga panuntunan.
- 9. Ang desisyon ng mga hurado ay pinal at hindi na mababago.
- 10. Ang pagmamay-ari ng mga isinumiteng materyales ay awtomatikong mapupunta sa Pamahalaang Lungsod ng Muntinlupa.
- 11. Ang mga nanalo ay iaanunsyo sa huling linggo ng Pebrero.

 - o Kaugnayan sa paksa
 - o Lalim ng mga ideya at argumento
 - Kalikhaan at orihinalidad
 - Pagkakaiba, emosyonal na resonance, at kakayahang makuha ang interes ng mambabasa.

2. Organisasyon at Pagkakaugnay-ugnay (20%)

- o Malinaw na panimula, katawan, at konklusyon
- o Lohikal na daloy ng mga ideya at pagkakaugnay-ugnay sa pagitan ng mga talata
- 3. Kalinawan at Estilo ng Wika (20%)
 - Malinaw na pagpapahayag
 - o Tamang gramatika, baybay, at bantas
- 4. Kritikal na Pag-iisip (15%)
 - o Kakayahang magsuri, mag-aral, at magbigay ng mga makabuluhang pananaw

5. Pagsunod sa mga Panuntunan (5%)

o Pagsunod sa limitasyon ng oras at mga alituntunin.

On-the-Spot Poster-Making Contest Guidelines and Mechanics

Theme: Muntinlupa City @ 30: Smart, Sustainable, Strong

Eligibility:

- 1. The contest is open to all bonafide Grade 5 and 6 elementary learners enrolled in any Public schools/institutions in the City of Muntinlupa.
- 2. Entries should be made on the spot.

Poster Making Specifications:

- 1. Orientation: Portrait only
- 2. Medium: Each participant will be provided with 1/4 illustration board and oil pastel.

Submission Details:

- 1. Deadline: February 12, 2025 (on the Day of the contest)
- 2. Submit entries to the Lead Person
- 3. Each submission must include with the following details:
 - o Contestant's full name
 - o Grade and section
 - Contact information
 - Contestant's entry number

Contest Mechanics:

- 1. The Poster-Making contest will be held on February 12, 2025 at 8:00AM.
- 2. The Poster-Making theme will be announced at the start of the contest.
- 3. After the announcement of the theme, participants will have 5 minutes to consult with their coaches.
- 4. Only three (3) hours is given to the contestants to finish their poster. A 10-minute extension will be given if the majority of the contestants are not able to finish their artwork on the given time.
- 5. The poster must be original, solely made by the contestant.

- 6. Only one contestant per school is allowed to join the poster making contest.
- 7. Posters must illustrate, interpret, and emphasize the theme provided.
- 8. Avoid any content that may be offensive, discriminatory, or inappropriate.
- 9. Posters will be judged based on creativity and presentation, originality, relevance to the theme, and adherence to instructions.
- 10. The panel of judges' decision is final and irrevocable.
- 11. The rights of the submitted materials will automatically belong to the City Government of Muntinlupa.
- 12. Winners will be announced in the last week of February.

Criteria for Judging

1. Creativity (30%)

- Contains elements that are creatively and correctly used (i. e., text, color, illustrations, etc.)
- Depth of ideas and uniqueness
- Incorporating imaginative elements, innovative approaches and design that enhance the overall presentation

2. Originality (30%)

- Stands out and shows a fresh, imaginative idea that grabs attention
- Strong original idea
- Showcases original ideas and concepts, setting it apart from others

3. Visual Impact (20%)

- * Attractive in terms of design, layout, and neatness.
- * Entices the audience at the first glance
- * Captures attention, leaving a strong and lasting impression

4. Relevance to the theme (20%)

- Clear and easily explains the theme
- Message is clear and powerful.
- Aligns with the theme
- Demonstrates deep understanding
