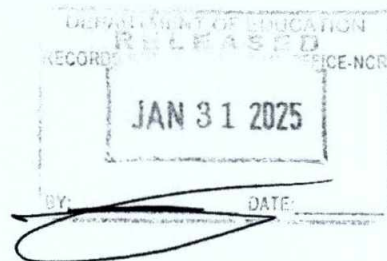

**49TH CAMP PAG-IBIG 2025**

1. The Department of Education- National Capital Region through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) in Partnership with the Philippine Association for Intellectual Disability, Inc. (PAFID), announces the conduct of the 49<sup>th</sup> Camp Pag-ibig in celebration of the 2025 National Intellectual Disability Week with the Theme "Ang Inclusion ay Pag-ibig", on February 15-16, 2025, at the Balara Filter Plant, Quezon City.
2. This year's activity is expecting the usual attendance of one thousand five hundred organizers, teachers and volunteers. Enclosed is the list of required participants (SNED Coordinator, Principal, Sped Learners, Sped Teachers, Parents/Guardians) per division.
3. Consequently, Regional officials and members of the Technical Working Group (TWG) are enjoined to be at the venue on February 15, 2025, (Saturday) 8:00 A.M to 5:00 PM to facilitate the preparation for the said activity.
4. The personnel involved shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with **DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2024**, titled Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers. Meanwhile, non-teaching personnel, including management staff shall be granted Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) as provided under **Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004**, *Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered*, with particular attention to section 5.
5. Travel and other incidental expenses of the aforementioned officials, TWG and participants shall be charged against school MOOE/local funds/SPED funds or Other sources, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

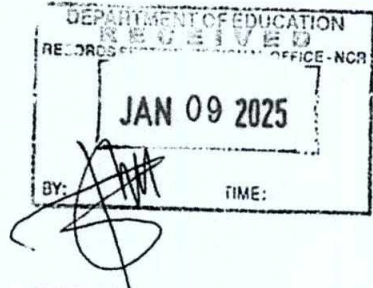
