Ground Rules: Official Basketball Rules and Volleyball Rules

Code of Ethics

E 1 1 1 1 1

- I. Players' Code of Ethics
 - a. Played by the rules.
 - b. Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your team captain or coach approach the official during a break or after the game.
 - c. Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players. Deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not allowed in any sports.
 - d. Work hard for yourself or for your team to achieve excellence. Your team performance will benefit.
 - e. Be a good sport. Appreciate all the players whether they may be your team, opponent, or another team.
 - f. Treat all the players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with the bully or take advantage of any player.
 - g. Cooperate with your coach, teammates, and opponents. Without them, there will be no competition.
 - h. Play for all the fun of it and not just to please your parents and coaches.
 - i. Avoid the use of derogatory words.

II. Coaches' Code of Ethics

- a. Be reasonable in your demands on your players' time, energy, and enthusiasm.
- b. Teach your players that the rules of the sports are mutual agreements that no one should break.
- c. Whenever possible, give each player a reasonable chance of success.
- d. Avoid overplaying the talented players. The just-average players need and deserve equal time.
- e. Remember that students participate for fun and enjoyment and that winning is just a part of their motivation. Never ridicule or yell at the athletes.
- f. Ensure that equipment and facilities meet safety standards and are appropriate to the age and ability of the players.
- g. Take into consideration of the maturity level of students, when scheduling and determining the length of practice time and competition.
- Follow the advice of the physician when determining whether an injured player is ready to recommence training or competition.
- Make a personal commitment to keep yourself informed of sound coaching principles and the principles of growth and development of children.
- j. Avoid the use of derogatory words.
