- 3. The materials to be used by each school are funded by the stakeholder, PTC-CSJ Foundation. Other existing teacher-made learning materials can also be utilized if needed. This activity shall be monitored by the PSDSs in-charge of each school and EPS for Kindergarten.

Mechanics of the Program

- 1. This activity will be conducted by all public elementary schools as this would be the Kindergarten Performance Activity for SY 2024-2025.
- There would be a division wide orientation on how this should be done. (Classroom – based activity) With the assistance of the School Head, the school's kindergarten coordinator shall take charge of planning and preparing the venue, materials and other logistics to be used. Technical assistance from the Schools Division Office shall also be provided.
- 3. This is a fun play-based method learning activity except the conduct of Reading Assessment using Reading Assessment Sheet 1-3, where all the kindergarten must undergo. Classrooms shall be used for the activities.
- 4. The materials to be used are the existing or available materials the teachers have in their classrooms, but they may produce new ones that are appropriate for the activity which is aligned to numeracy and literacy skills.
- 5. There would be six bases to be manned/facilitated by Kindergarten teachers. The school may tap parent volunteers /SPTA Officers to assist and to ensure safety of the learners while participating in the said activity.
- 6. Each school will receive three thousand pesos from PTC CSJ Foundation through Synergeia Foundation to augment the existing materials that are needed for the event. The said amount shall be received and liquidated by the Kindergarten Coordinator.
- 7. For the monitoring of the learner's completion of the activities, the teacheradviser will prepare an activity card (bond paper only) for each learner. Each based facilitator will stamp a smiley face in the activity card each time the child finishes the challenge in a base.
- 8. The school coordinator shall submit a narrative report with complete documentation including the result of the Reading Assessment conducted shall be submitted to SDO-Muntinlupa and a copy for the PTC-CSJ Foundation.

ASSESSMENT TOOL #1: Book & Print Orientation Test

The 15-item test is administered individually with the help of a book for about 5 minutes. The child scores 1 point for every correct response. A score below 6 points means he/she needs more experience with books and print. A score of 6 points and above means he/she is ready to learn to read.

Directions for Administering the Test

Ask the child to get one book from a pile of story books.
