In line with the Department of Education's commitment to fostering a culture of peace and active citizenship within schools, the "*Project ACE (Active Citizenship Engagement): Empowering Educators – Developing a Competency Compendium for a Strengthened Peace Education in the K to 10 Curriculum*" will be conducted via blended modality on March 31 - April 5, 2025, with the In-Person sessions happening at the Resto Bar, Tunasan National High School, Tunasan, Muntinlupa City.


