II. BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE

The DOST, through its regional offices, is implementing the "Community Empowerment through Science and Technology (CEST)" Program. The objective of the program is to empower the most economically challenged communities in the country through the provision of Science and Technology (S&T) interventions of the expanded components in Education, Industry Development, Health & Nutrition, Environmental Sanitation and Conservation, and Disaster Risk Reduction and Climate Change Adaptation. These main entry points are utilized to empower communities and propel development. The CEST program envisions a Filipino society of progressive and empowered communities that have an active role in decision-making as part of a greater society.

Through the *"Human Resource and Development"* pillar of the CEST program, the DOST-NCR conducts an annual review class for the SEI Undergraduate Scholarship applicants in NCR. The topics that will be covered during the review sessions are as follows:

- 1. Biology;
- 2. Chemistry;
- 3. Physics;
- Mathematics;
- 5. English; and
- 6. Verbal and Non-Verbal.

III. OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the said activity are as follows:

- 1. To enhance access to S&T information and increase students' interest in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) courses; and
- 2. To assist the applicants prepare themselves for the SEI undergraduate scholarship examination.
