The project was being conceptualized by the DILG and BFP which aimed to create a more effective awareness campaign for children especially on fire safety and prevention. Teaching modules were developed by the DepEd curriculum specialist and writers and was supported by MERALCO by producing learning video to cover other facets of learning.

The Kiddie/ Junior Fire Marshal Project was launched by DILG, BFP and DepED last year 2006 at Ramon Magsaysay High School and at Pampanga Convention Center. Subsequently, being implemented nationwide as part of the regular fire prevention activities of the BFP.

The Junior Fire Marshall Program aimed to educate the students on Fire and other fire related activities, Emergency Medical and Rescue, and other disaster related activities thru series of training, games, actual exercises and a friendly



competition. Through this, it continued to open the mind of the young generations to be responsible enough to help their school and the community in prevention and to respond in different kinds of disasters.

This will be a continuing project promoting volunteerism and making our young generations to be responsible citizens and soon will be helping the Bureau of Fire Protection and Muntinlupa City Disaster Risk and Reduction Management Office in rendering service to the public.
