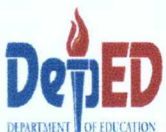
Target participants are school educators, researchers, and other professionals from public and private schools.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR NRSEL 2025

Instructions for authors:

Thank you for choosing to submit your abstract to us. These instructions will facilitate the seamless review of your abstract. Please take the time to read and follow the instructions as closely as possible to ensure that your submission meets the NRSEL 2025's requirements.

Style Guidelines:

1. The NRSEL is accepting abstract submissions in English (American) and Filipino.
2. For the title, use bold Times New Roman font size 12, centered. Capitalize all proper nouns, and do not use a period at the end of the title.
3. Authors must significantly contribute to the article's intellectual content. After submission, all co-authors are responsible for their contributions, having approved the final version and its submission to the NRSEL.
4. Times New Roman font size 12 with 1.5 spacing should be used for the abstract, in a letter-sized (8.5 inches x 11 inches) document with 1-inch margins. The page numbers must also be placed at the upper right-hand corner of the pages.
5. The abstract should have 200-250 words, excluding the in-text citations and references, and is structured as follows: introduction (brief conceptual bases, purpose and research aims, significance), methodology (design and key methods used), results (findings addressing the research aims), and conclusions.
6. Supply 5 keywords for your abstract to help organizers and readers locate your article.
7. Referencing and citations should follow the APA 7th edition guidelines. Use Times New Roman font size 12 for these as well.
8. The acknowledgments for funders and grant-giving institutions of the research/study should be reported. Additionally, this is where collaborators who permitted third-party content can be recognized.

Article Submission:

1. The abstract should be submitted in Microsoft Word format (or its equivalent) or as a PDF using the following file naming convention: Track number_Surname_First name.doc/pdf (example: Track 1_Buenviaje_Jerome.pdf)
2. Use the recommended content format as follows:
 - a. Title (example: Basic Education ICT for Governance, Finance, and School Improvement)
 - b. Author/s (example: Jerome T. Buenviaje, PhD)
 - c. Affiliation/Institution (example: Educational Administration Area, UP College of Education)
 - d. Abstract
 - e. Keywords (keyword 1, keyword 2, keyword 3, keyword 4, keyword 5)

3. For abstracts with multiple authors, a corresponding author must be designated to communicate with the NRSEL Team regarding abstract submission.
4. Abstracts must be submitted using the following link:
