**REITERATION OF STRICT COMPLIANCE WITH ANTI-BULLYING ISSUANCES**

1. To promote the safety and well-being of all learners in SDO-Muntinlupa City, this Office reiterates strict compliance of all schools with the existing Anti-Bullying issuances, as follows:

- Division Memorandum No. 109, s. 2025 – Reiteration of Strict Compliance with the Department of Education (DepEd) Order No. 55, s. 2013, titled, Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 10627, Otherwise Known as the Anti-Bullying Act of 2013
- DepEd Order No. 55, s. 2013 - Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 10627 Otherwise Known as The Anti-Bullying Act of 2013
- DepEd Order No. 18, s. 2015 – DepEd Guidelines and Procedures on the Management of Children-at-Risk (CAR) and Children in Conflict with the Law (CICL)
- DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 – DepEd Child Protection Policy

2. All schools are reminded of their responsibility of ensuring a safe, supportive, and respectful learning environment for every learner. Relative to this, the following key provisions shall be regularly implemented in the schools:

- Capacity-building on School Child Protection Committee (SCPC) Functionality
- Timely and appropriate interventions for the learners, with the involvement of parents/guardians and proper documentation
- Submission of bullying incident reports, intervention plans, and intake sheets to the Division Office for recording and monitoring
- Information dissemination activities for the learners, personnel, and parents on bullying prevention advocacy
