

Audition Mechanics

1. Eligibility:

- Open to all **Grades 4 to 6 learners** currently enrolled in SDO Muntinlupa public schools
- Must have a passion for singing and willingness to undergo training and performances

2. Submission Process:

- Applicants must submit a **clear video recording** of themselves singing ANY of the following songs: (1) Lupang Hinirang (2) Muntinlupa March (3) Doxology (4) SDO Hymn
- The video must be recorded **a cappella** (without background music) to assess vocal clarity and range.
- The learner must be fully visible in the frame while singing.
- The recording must be well-lit and free from background noise.
- File name format: **[School Name] [Full Name] MuntingTanglaw.mp4**
- Submissions should be sent via email with the subject line: **Munting Tanglaw Audition - [Name of Learner]** to the Division Public Assistance email: pac.sdomuntinlupa@gmail.com.
- Shortlisted applicants will be notified via their school and invited for an in-person final audition.
- The final selection will determine the official members of *Munting Tanglaw* who will receive voice training and participate in official Division events.

3. Evaluation Criteria:

- **Vocal Quality & Tone** – 40%
- **Pitch Accuracy** – 30%
- **Expression & Interpretation** – 20%
- **Clarity of Words & Diction** – 10%
