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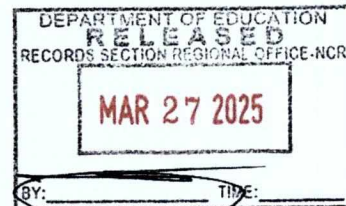

1. The Department of Education has entered a partnership with Canva Philippines through the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on October 30, 2024. This partnership grants free access to Canva for Education for all DepEd personnel and learners, alongside comprehensive training, professional development, and student engagement programs.
2. As part of the initial implementation, the Canva Philippines will conduct the pilot rollout of Canva for Education licenses for all learners in the National Capital Region (NCR). 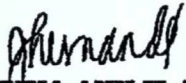
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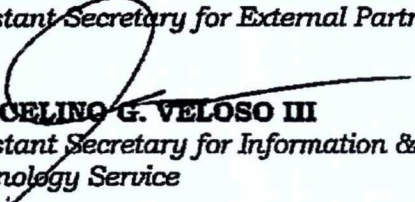

DATE : March 7, 2025

The Department of Education (DepEd), led by Secretary Sonny Angara, formally entered a partnership with Canva Philippines through the signing of a **Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on October 30, 2024**. This partnership grants free access to **Canva for Education** for all DepEd personnel and learners, alongside **comprehensive training, professional development, and student engagement programs**. Through this collaboration, DepEd aims to enhance digital literacy, elevate the teaching and learning experience, and equip educators and students with 21st-century skills.

Key Areas of Collaboration

Under this initiative, DepEd and Canva will focus on the following areas:

1. **Bridging the Digital and Classroom Gaps**
 - a. Assessing the impact of technology on learning outcomes.
2. **Teacher Upskilling and Professional Development**
 - a. Exploring a **nationwide Canva upskilling program** in partnership with the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP).
3. **Enhancing Digital Literacy and Critical Thinking**
 - a. Introducing design challenges and projects that promote creative problem-solving skills.

- b. Developing essential digital and design literacy skills, including visual communication, creativity, and critical thinking.
- 4. Promoting Learner Well-being and Leadership**
 - a. Encouraging learner independence in Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (GIDAs).
- 5. Fostering a Child-Centered Learning Environment**
 - a. Integrating personalized learning and promoting inclusivity in education.

Pilot Rollout in the National Capital Region (NCR)

As part of the initial implementation, we are pleased to announce the **pilot rollout of Canva for Education licenses** for all learners in the **National Capital Region (NCR)**. Canva Philippines, in collaboration with DepEd's **External Partnerships Service (EPS)** and **Information and Communications Technology Service (ICTS)**, will closely coordinate with the regional office to ensure successful deployment.

To support this initiative, the following programs will be conducted in partnership with DepEd ICTS and DepEd NCR:

Programs under the Canva for Education Pilot in NCR:

- 1. Technical Setup of the NCR Canva Team with the ICTS Office**
 - a. Coordination with the DepEd ICTS team for account management.
 - b. Deployment of necessary support to ensure access for all NCR learners.
- 2. Orientation Session for All NCR DepEd Personnel on Canva for Education**
 - a. Virtual and/or in-person orientation sessions for teachers, school heads, and DepEd personnel.
 - b. Overview of Canva's features, best practices, and integration into classroom instruction.
- 3. Teacher Essentials Certification Program for All NCR Teaching Personnel**
 - a. Capacity-building program focused on equipping teachers with essential skills to maximize Canva in lesson planning, instructional materials, and student engagement.
- 4. Pilot of Canva's Design School Certification Program**
 - a. A specialized training program for select NCR learners, focusing on digital storytelling and design-thinking skills.
- 5. Best Practices and Case Study on Canva for Education in NCR**
 - a. Documentation and analysis of best practices in implementing Canva for Education in NCR schools.
 - b. Development of a case study highlighting the impact on student engagement, learning outcomes, and teacher adoption.
 - c. Findings from the pilot will be used to inform future expansion and support the nationwide rollout.

The success of this pilot implementation will serve as the foundation for a **nationwide rollout** of Canva for Education in DepEd schools. We encourage all NCR schools and teachers to actively participate in the upcoming training sessions and certification programs.
