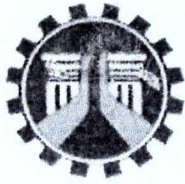

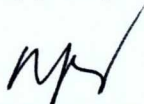

WHAT IS PSRRRP?

Philippine Seismic Risk Reduction and Resilience Project or 'PSRRRP' is a project that **aims to enhance the safety and seismic resilience** of the selected public buildings in Metro Manila and the capacity of DPWH to **prepare for and respond to emergencies**.

WHAT IS THE SCOPE OF THIS PROJECT?

This project will be retrofitting **425 public buildings** which are composed of **public school buildings and health facilities within Metro Manila** in preparation for 'The Big One'

WHO WILL IMPLEMENT THIS PROJECT?

This project is financed by **The World Bank** with IBRD Loan no. 9251-PH and will be **implemented by DPWH Central Office, Buildings and Special Projects Management Cluster (BSPMC) -Unified Projects Management Office (UPMO)**.

Ano ba ang PSRRRP?

Ang Philippine Seismic Risk Reduction and Resilience Project o 'PSRRRP' ay isang proyekto na **naglalayong pahasayin ang kaligtasan at katibayan pagdating sa lindol** ng mga piling pampublikong gusali sa Metro Manila at ang kapasidad ng DPWH **upang maghanda at tumugon sa mga emergencies**.

Ano ang sakop ng proyektong ito?

Ang proyektong ito ay papatibayin ang pundasyon ng **425 pampublikong gusali na binubuo ng mga pampublikong paaralan at pasilidad ng kalusugan sa loob ng Metro Manila** para sa paghahanda sa 'The Big One'.

Sino ang magpapatupad sa proyektong ito?

Ang proyektong ito ay **pinondohan World Bank** na may IBRD Loan no. 9251-PH at ipatutupad ng **DPWH Central Office, Buildings and Special Projects Management Cluster (BSPMC) -Unified Projects Management Office (UPMO)**.

WHO WILL BENEFIT FROM THIS PROJECT?



The Project will benefit **approximately 290,000 occupants** including teachers, students, doctors, patients, staff and other users of the public buildings to be retrofitted, and **about 12.9 million residents of Metro Manila** through the improved emergency preparedness and response of the Department, which will support early economic recovery from major natural catastrophic event.

Sino ang makikinabang sa proyektong ito?

Ang Proyekto ay makakatulong sa **humigit-kumulang 290,000 katao** sa mga pampublikong gusali na ire-retrofit kabilang ang mga guro, mag-aaral, doktor, pasyente, kawani at iba pang gumagamit nito, at **humigit-kumulang 12.9 milyong residente ng Metro Manila** sa pamamagitan ng pinabuting paghahanda at pagtugon sa emerhensiya ng Departamento, na susuporta sa maagang pagbangon ng ekonomiya mula sa pangunahing natural na sakuna.

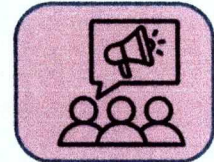


HOW CAN OUR COMMUNITY HELP WITH THIS PROJECT?

The community can help the project by being **active in public meetings** and **actively ask questions** to have the right information about the project.

Paano makakatulong ang komunidad sa proyektong ito?

ASSESSMENT

Qualified buildings will be assessed to determine the exact retrofitting process to be used. This involves a **physical inspection** by engineers together with an evaluation (through surveys and interviews) of the environmental and social impacts of the proposed construction and the possible **mitigating measures**.



ASSESSMENT

PLANNING & CONSULTATION

Detailed plans for construction will be drafted for implementation by contractors. More importantly, all **stakeholders will be consulted** on the social impact – everyone using the buildings as well as those who may be affected by any construction. The end result is an area-specific plan that takes all possible effects into account and addresses them practicably.



PLANNING & CONSULTATION

Gagawin ang **detalyadong plano** para sa contractor. Magkakaroon din ng **konsultasyon** sa lahat ng gumagamit ng gusali at lahat ng maaapektuhan ng paggawang magaganap. IMPLEMENTATION

Depending on the exact process to be used and other circumstances, **civil works may take a few weeks to several months**. During this time, implementation of the agreed-upon plans will be **closely monitored**. Any necessary adjustments will be made to ensure that the school or health facility operates as normally as possible.



IMPLEMENTATION

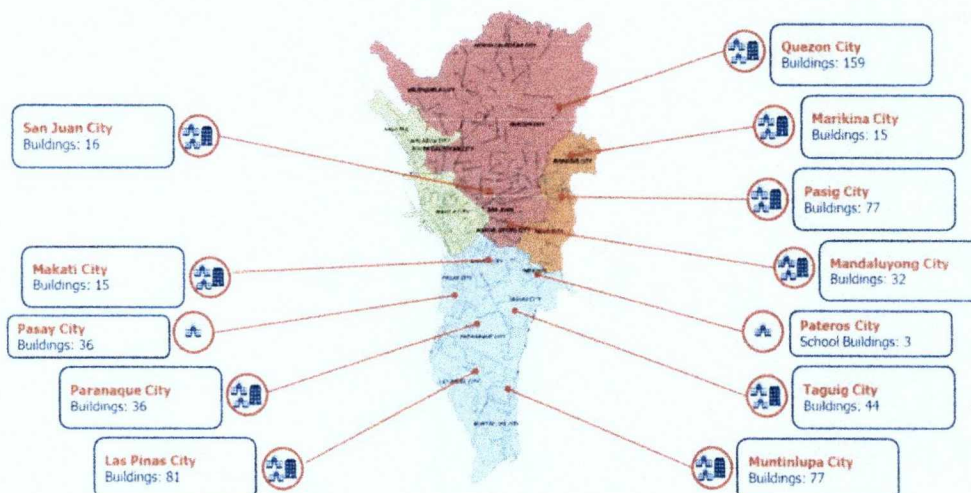
