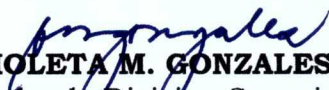

**INDUCTION OF THE ANTI-BULLYING AMBASSADORS (ABA) OF THE PUBLIC
ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN THE CITY OF MUNTINLUPA**

1. Pursuant to the Division Memorandum No. 109, s. 2025, titled *Reiteration of the Strict Compliance with the Department of Education (DepEd) Order No. 55, s. 2013, titled, Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the Republic Act (RA) No. 10627, Otherwise Known as the Anti-Bullying Act of 2013*, the Schools Division Office of Muntinlupa City held an induction of the Anti-Bullying Ambassadors last March 5, 2025. Relative to this, **all Officers of the Supreme Elementary/Secondary Learner Government and other School Clubs and Organizations** are hereby designated as ABAs, **starting SY 2025-2026 and in the succeeding school years.**
2. The main duty of the ambassadors is to represent and advocate for a Zero Bullying School, raising awareness, and influencing positive change.
3. The Anti-Bullying Ambassadors are expected to foster a safe, inclusive, and learner-centered environment in their respective schools by:
 - a. Leading by example as role models in treating others with kindness, respect, and empathy.
 - b. Educating and empowering fellow students on the impact of bullying and the importance of standing up against it.
 - c. Intervening and reporting bullying incidents responsibly to ensure a supportive and just school environment.
 - d. Encouraging peer support and inclusivity to create a culture where every learner feels valued and safe.
4. The entire school community, including the school head, teaching and non-teaching personnel, SPTA, and all other stakeholders shall extend support to the pupil/student leaders in the execution of their functions as Anti-Bullying Ambassadors.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of, and compliance to this Memorandum is desired.
