CONSOLIDATION OF NUMBER OF GADGETS, DEVICES, AND INTERNET/DATA CONNECTIVITY IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN PREPARATION FOR THE ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY MODE (ADM), SY 2025-2026

1. In reference to DepEd Order No. 21, s. 2019 titled "Policy Guidelines on the K to 12 Basic Education Program", which underscores the delivery of responsive and context-based education, and in preparation for the continued implementation of Alternative Delivery Modes (ADM) in School Year 2025–2026, all public elementary and secondary schools are directed to conduct a school-level consolidation of available gadgets and internet/data connectivity for School Year 2025–2026.
2. This data collection aims to assess the readiness of schools and learners for ADM and to support the Department in planning interventions that ensure equitable access to learning.
3. All schools must use the prescribed online consolidation data capture accessible via this link: **<https://bit.ly/M07-GADGETS-INTERNET-DATA-CONNECTION-ADM>**.
4. Designated ICT Coordinators, Administrative Officers, Property & Supply Custodians or School Planning Team members shall lead the encoding and validation of data.
5. The data gathered will serve as basis for:
 - Resource allocation and support under ADM
 - Targeted provision of printed modules or digital packages
 - Partnerships with LGUs or private organizations
 - Improving learning delivery modalities tailored to school and community context
6. Deadline for submission is **on or before June 27, 2025**. Timely submission of this data capture to aid the Division Office in planning and policy monitoring this school year.
7. This initiative is aligned with the Department's commitment to ensure that "no learner is left behind" by providing flexible, inclusive, and technology-supported learning options.


