

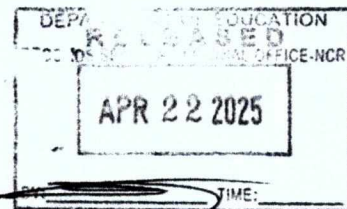

 - upskill Education Program Specialist II-ALS on new knowledge or information to help them perform their job roles effectively
